the owner of the Monument known as Plunton Castle (in ruins) situated within a triangular area of ground measuring 100 yards along each of its west and north sides and 150 yards along its south-east side, the eastmost corner of said area being situated on the edge of a foot path leading in a general south-easterly direction from the Gatehouse of Fleet-Knockbrev road to Bridge-end, 90 yards south east of the Plunton Burn at its nearest point and 480 yards south by west of the Bench Mark 183.7 on the south-east corner of Lennox Plunton Farm Buildings

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Lennox Plunton Farm

situated in the Parish of Borgue and County of the Stewartry of Kirkcudbright.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

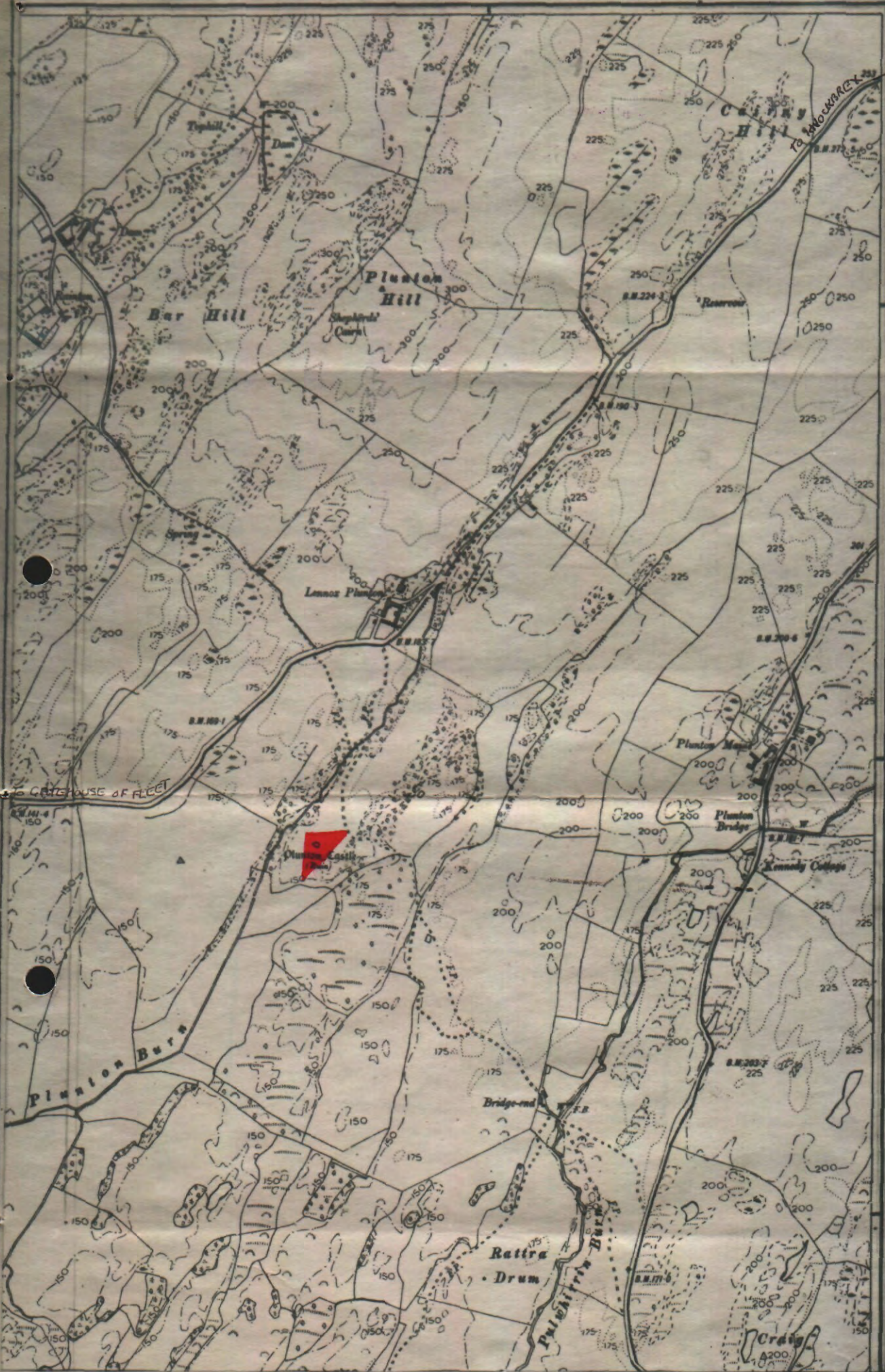

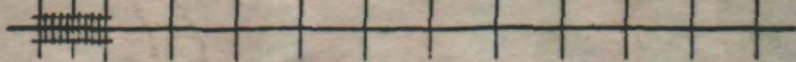
