**IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS
ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.**

To THE PROVOST, MAGISTRATES AND COUNCILLORS OF THE BURGH OF MOTHERWELL AND WISHAW, Town Hall, Motherwell,

the owners of part of the Monument known as The Roman Fort, Bothwellhaugh, contained within an area of ground lying to the south-west of a metalled foot-road known as Watling Street or Roman Road, which area of ground is contained within a trapezoidal figure measuring on its north-west and south-east sides 700 feet or thereby, on its north-east side 825 feet or thereby and on its south-west side 750 feet or thereby being that part of said area marked "B" on the plan aftermentioned,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Logan's Plantation

situated in the Parish of Bothwell and
County of Lanark.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

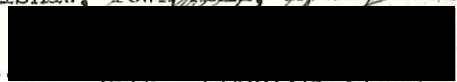

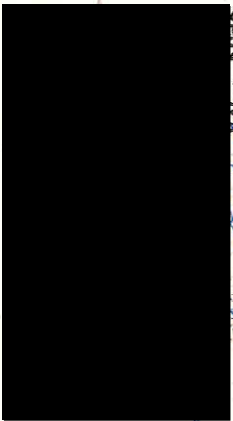
