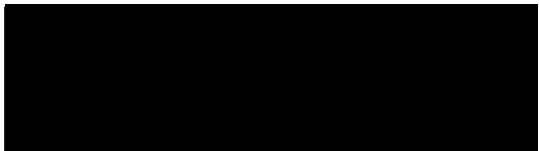
IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

To the owner of the Monument known as Moat contained within a circular area of ground 70 yards in diameter the southmost point of said area of ground being situated 105 yards north north east of the milestone 26 miles from Edinburgh on the public road between Edinburgh and Lanark through Carnwath, 110 yards west north west of Carnwath Burn at its nearest point and 230 yards east by south of Bench Mark 703.3 on the said public road, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being now or formerly part of the property known as the lands of Moat Park situated in the parish of Carnwath and County of Lanark.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

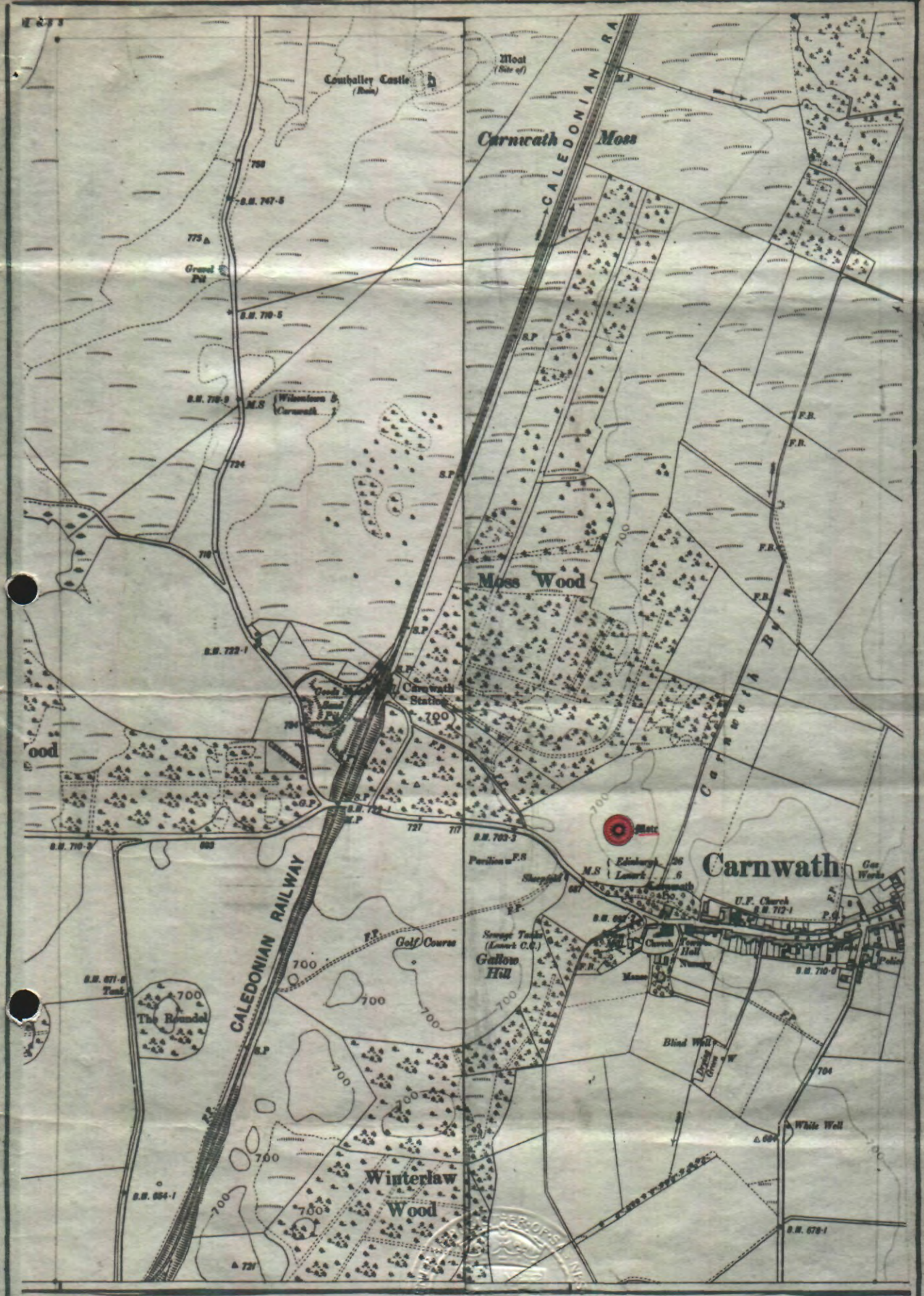
