

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Hallbar Tower, barmkin, comprises a barmkin adjacent to Hallbar towerhouse built around 1581 and repaired in 1861. The tower itself is excluded from the scheduling, while the barmkin remains scheduled. The area to be scheduled includes the barmkin and an area around in which remains associated with its construction and use are likely to survive. It measures a maximum of c.70m NE-SW by c 48m NW-SE. It is defined on the N and NE by the SE and SW walls of Hallbar tower (which are specifically excluded) and by the S edge of a track, on the W and NW by the boundary wall/fence and on the SW and SE by Braidwood Burn. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Carluke and the County of Lanark as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

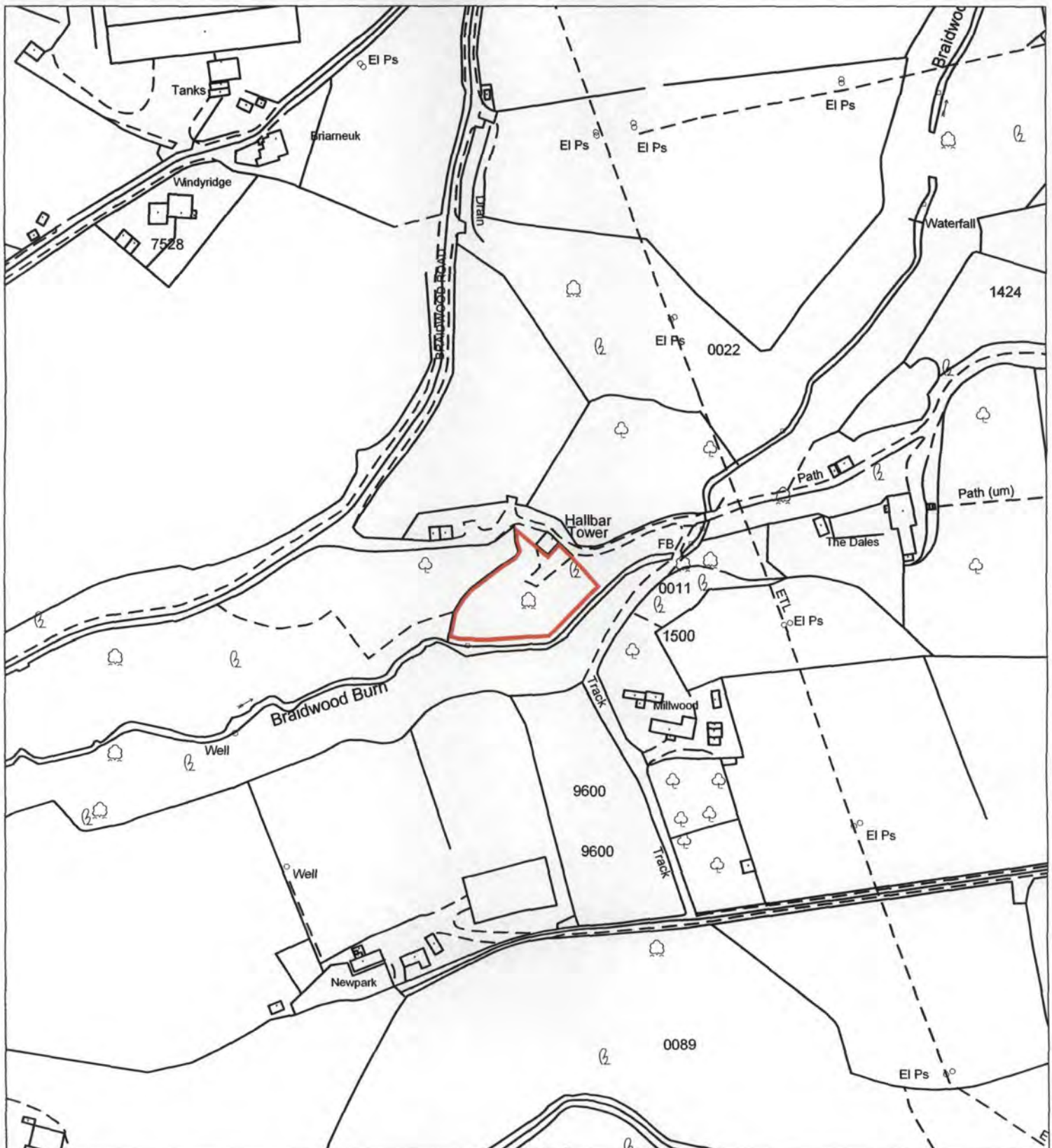

Scheduled Area

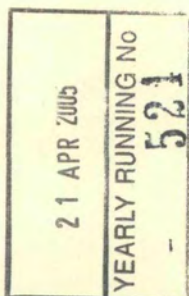
