**IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS
ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.**

[redacted] recorded 15th January 1910: said Earl having power alone to manage said Trust as sole [redacted]

the owners of the Monument known as cairn measuring 55 feet in diameter and situated on the summit of the East Cairn Hill 390 yards north-west by north of the boundary between the counties of Edinburgh and Peebles at its nearest point 650 yards west-north-west of the point where the boundary between the parishes of Currie and Midcalder meets said county boundary and 630 yards east by north of the old drove road between Harper Rig and West Linton passing over the Cauld Stane Slap, at its nearest point

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Harperrig Farm

situated in the Parish of Midcalder and County of Edinburgh.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
