[REDACTED] the owner of the Monument known as "Caly Stone" (standing stone) situated on the north side of Oxfangs Road leading west from Fairmilehead in the City of Edinburgh, 280 yards east of the junction of said road with the road leading southwards to Swanston Water Filters 460 yards south-south-east of Comiston House and 570 yards west by north of the cross-roads at Fairmilehead, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Comiston Farm, situated in the City Parish and County of Edinburgh.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

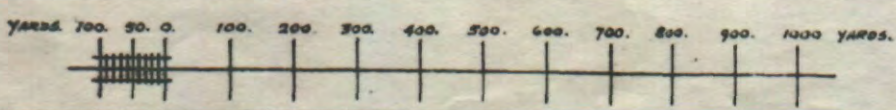
