IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

[REDACTED] the owner of part of the Monument known as fort occupying an oval area of ground on Lawhead Hill having a maximum length from north-east to south-west of 130 yards and a maximum breadth from south-east to north-west of 100 yards said fort being situated on either side of a dyke erected over said Hill 680 yards north-west by north of the northmost corner of Lawhead Farm Steading, 940 yards west-north-west of the south-west corner of Marchwell Farm Steading and 650 yards south-west of Turnhouse being the subjects indicated in red and yellow colour on the annexed plan whereof the part belonging to you, the said [REDACTED] is the portion lying to the South of said dyke and coloured yellow on said annexed plan, being part of the property known as Lawhead Farm situated in the Parish of Glencorse and County of Edinburgh.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

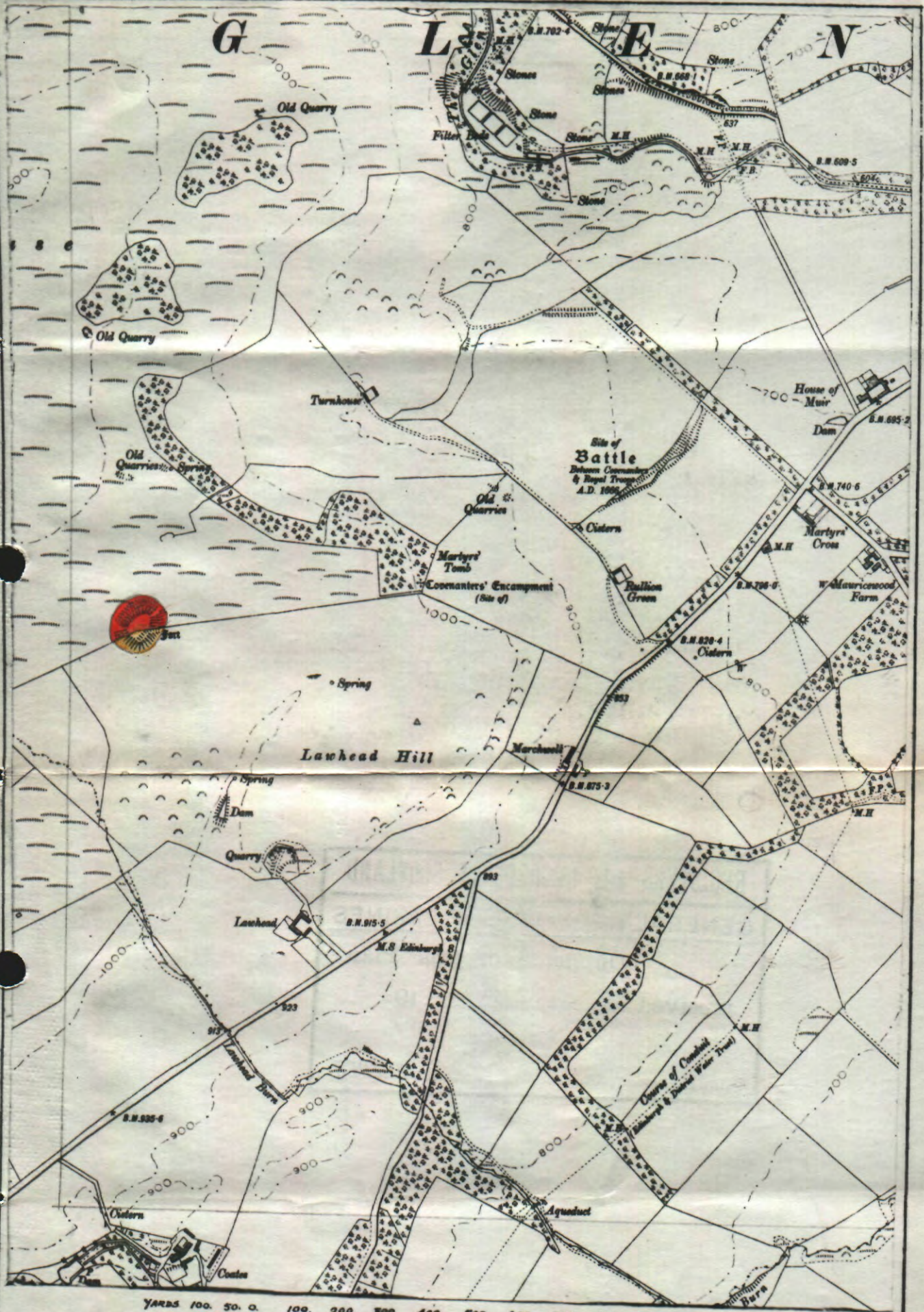
