

The monument known as Bogton, stone circle 250m NW of comprises the remains of a stone circle. The area to be scheduled measures 40m in diameter, to include the surviving stones, the area once occupied by the complete circle, and an area around and between the stones in which features associated with the construction and use of the monument are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of St Andrews-Lhanbryde and the County of Moray as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

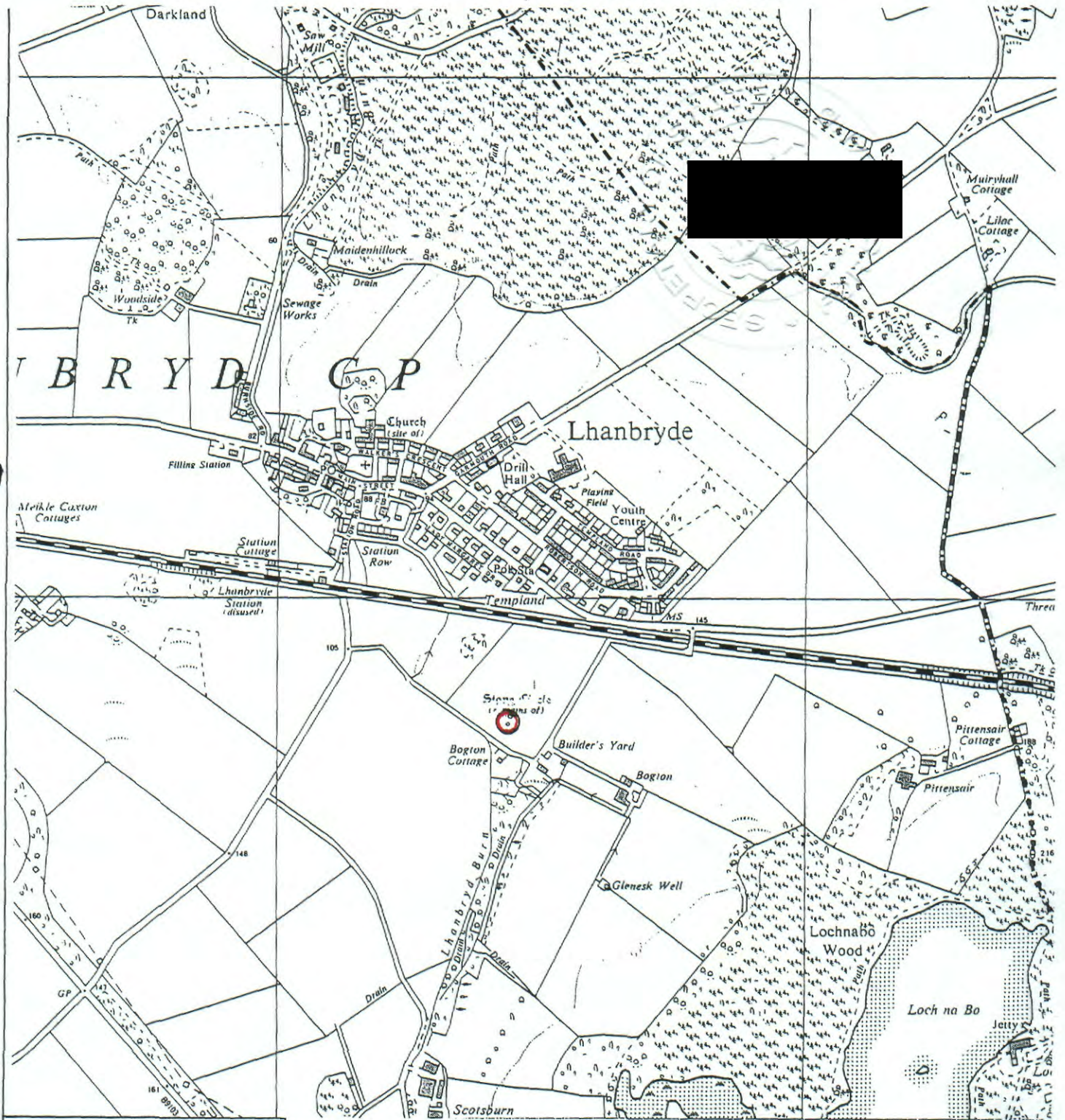

Scheduled area

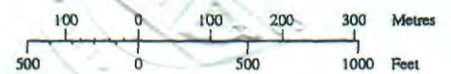
Bogton, stone circle 250m NW of
