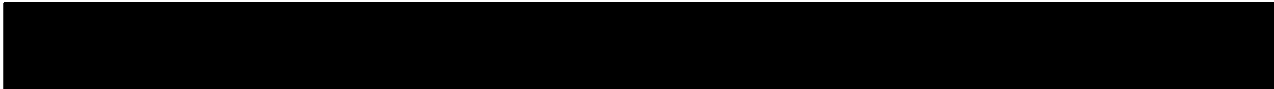


IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.



the owner of the Monuments known as the three chambered cairns contained within an oval area of ground on the Calf of Eday, measuring 180 yards at its greatest length from north by west to south by east and 80 yards at its greatest width from west by south to east by north, the southmost point of said area being 40 yards north-north-west at its nearest point of the high water mark between Caithness Geos and Quarrel Geos on the south-west shore of the said Calf of Eday, 570 yards south-east by east of said high water mark on the westmost point of Starling Ayre, and 490 yards north-east of the eastmost point of the buildings at South Cott on the Island of Eday

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of

the property known as the farm of Carrick, Sheepwalk Head and Holm, part of the lands and Estate of Eday and others

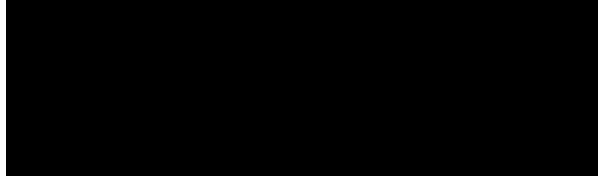
situated in the Parish of Eday and

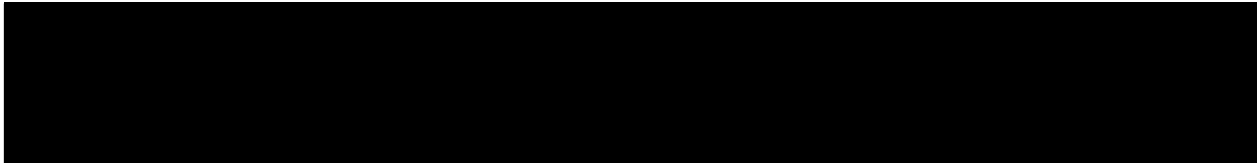
