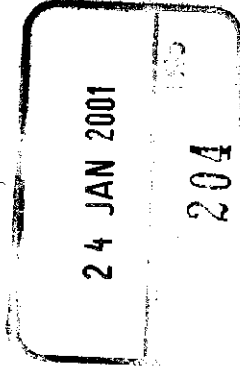

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Esgar, two burnt mounds WSW of, Dounby comprises two oval burnt mounds, in close proximity, within poorly drained land. The area to be scheduled is a square 30m on all sides and aligned NE-SW, to include both mounds and an area of ground extending 5m out from the outer edge of each mound on all sides, and includes the probable ancient shore-line of the loch. The scheduling specifically excludes the modern post and wire fence that crosses the SE part of the scheduled area. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Birsay and Harray and the County of Orkney and Zetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

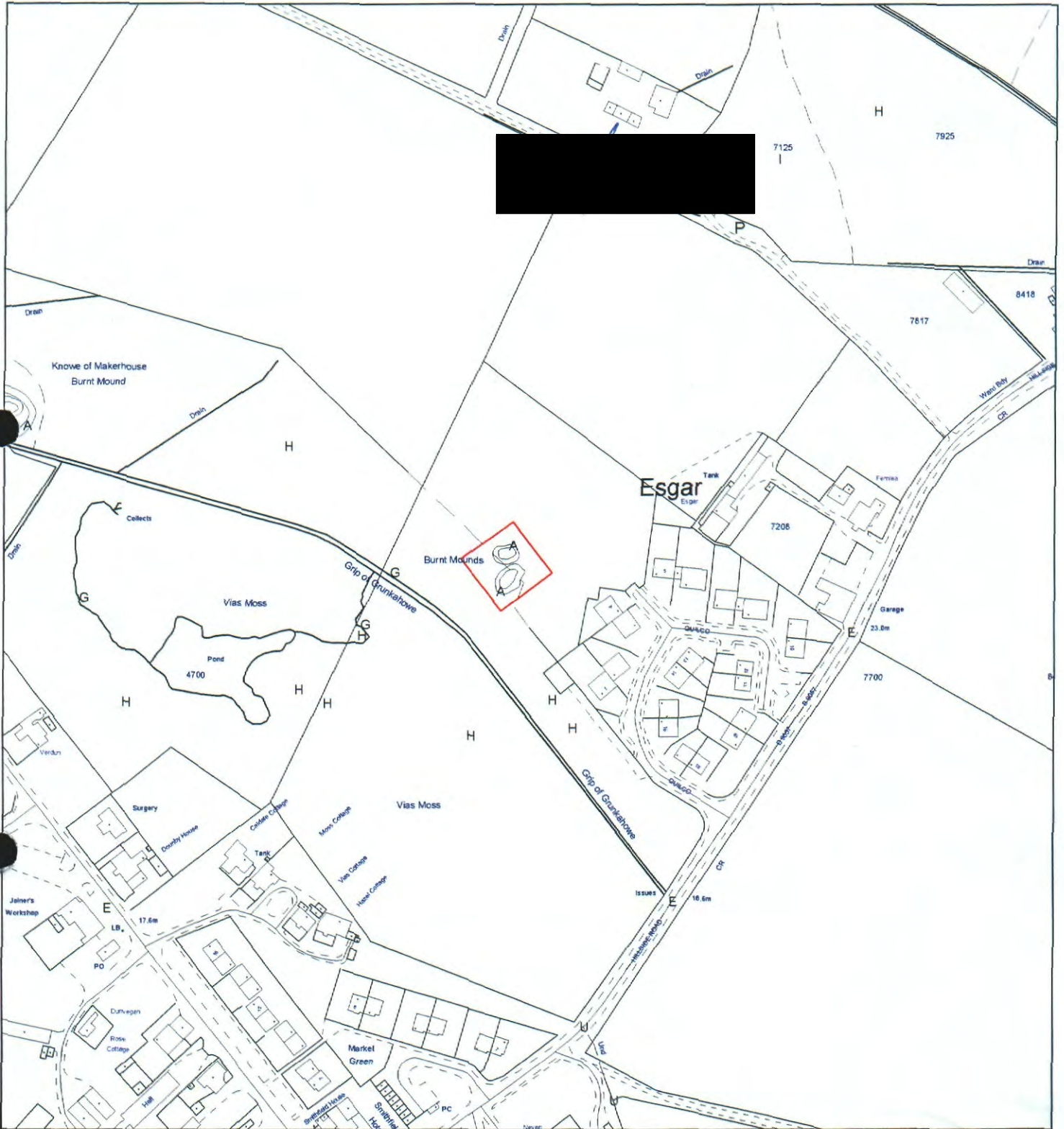
