## IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

the owners of the Monument known as "The Ring of Bookan" occupying an oval area of ground measuring 90 yards at its greatest length from north-east to south-west and 70 yards at its greatest width from south-east to north-west, the north-eastmost point of said area being situated 80 yards south by east at its nearest point of the road between Bridge of Brodgar and Skail, 140 yards south-west by west of the south-westmost corner of the main block of farm buildings at Bookan and 460 yards north-east by north of the north-east shore of the Loch of Stenness at its nearest point, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm of Buckan in the Township of Wasbuster situated in the Parish of Sandwick and County of Orkney.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

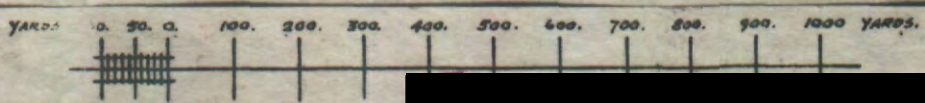
