

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Stones of Via, enclosure and stone setting, Loch of Clumly, comprises the remains of a prehistoric stone setting, lying just off-centre within a very extensive but now much flattened oval embankment. The stone setting, which comprises a massive stone slab and a group of six large stone blocks set in the ground, forms the most visible element of the monument. The area to be scheduled is oval, measuring 108m NW-SE by 95m NE-SW, centred on the centre of the enclosure. It includes the group of stones and the sub-surface remains of the enclosure, and an area around them in which evidence relating to the construction and use of the monument is likely to survive. The top 30cm of the track that overlies the enclosure on its NW arc, and the fence that abuts that track, are excluded from the scheduling to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Sandwick and the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

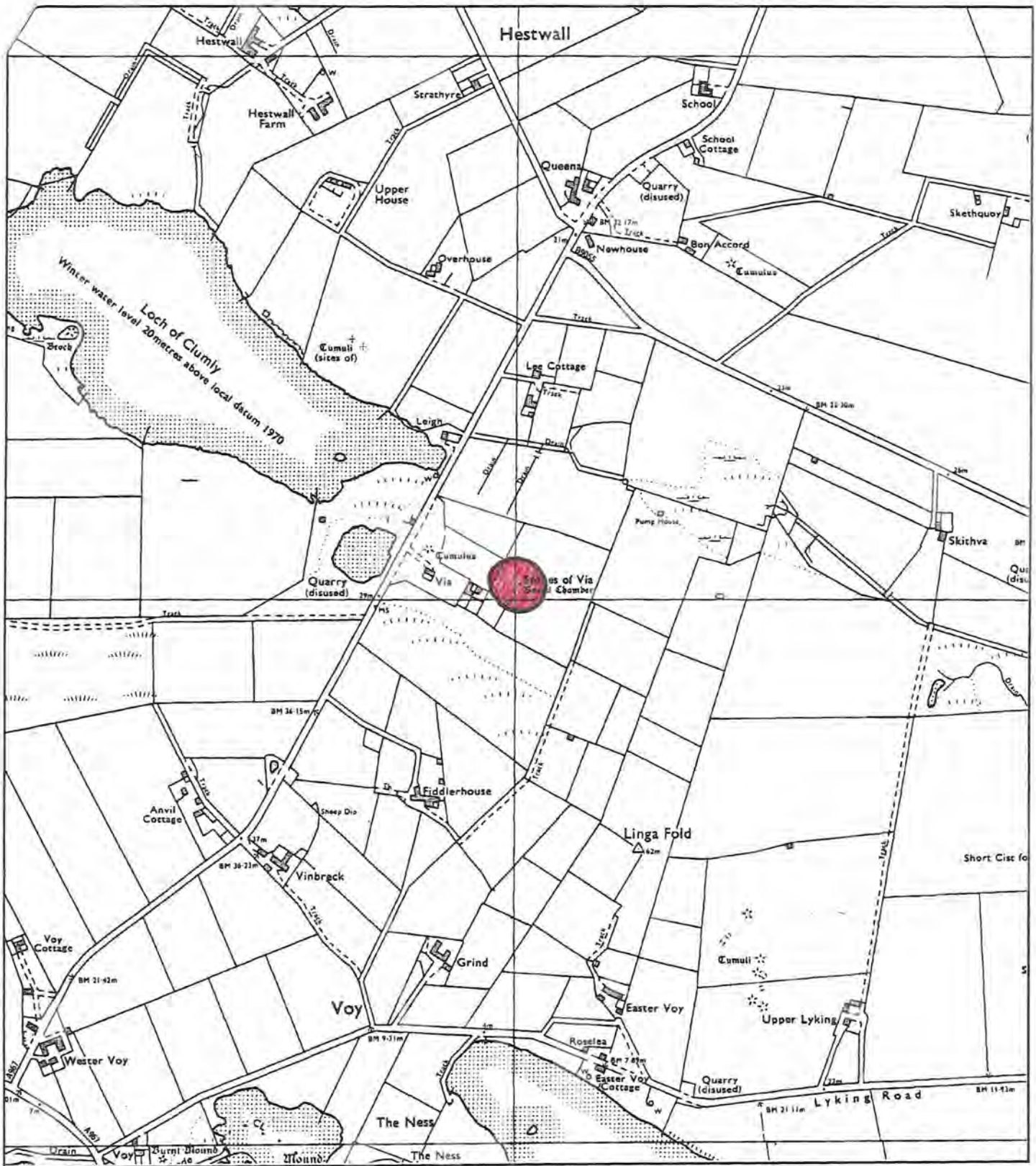
