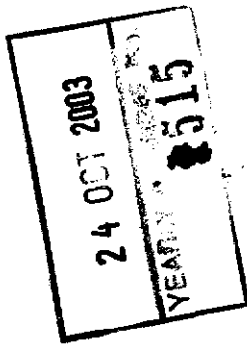

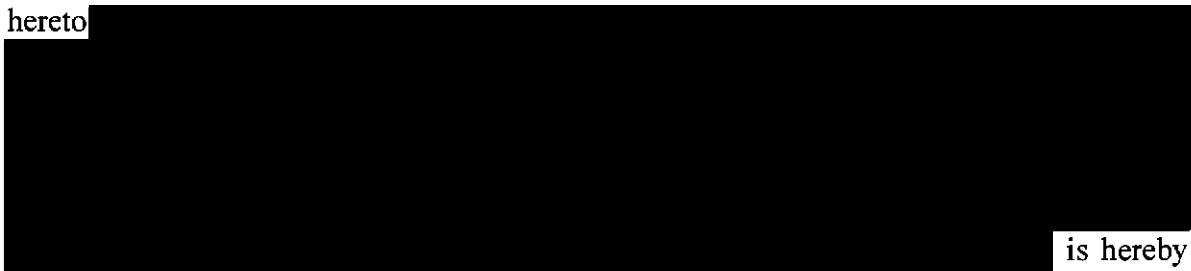

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Drochil Castle, comprises a large-scale fortified residence, with two parallel ranges of rooms set on each side of a broad central gallery to each floor, and with round towers at the diagonally opposite north-east and south-west corners. The area to be scheduled is irregular, with maximum dimensions of 80m from east to west and 74.5m from north to south. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Newlands and the County of Peebles as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

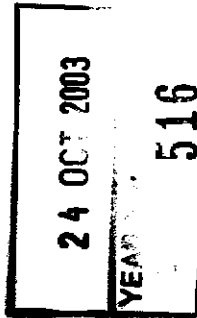
