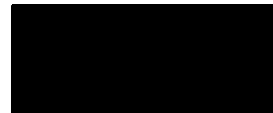
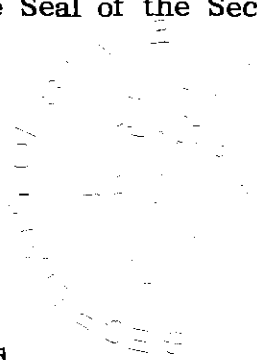
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Auchingarrich Farm, standing stone, Comrie, comprises a standing stone of the Bronze Age, 3000 to 4000 years old situated on top of a natural knoll to the SW of Auchingarrich Farm. The area to be scheduled includes the stone and an area around it within which traces of activity associated with its use may be found. The area is a circle 20m in diameter centred on the stone. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Muthill and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

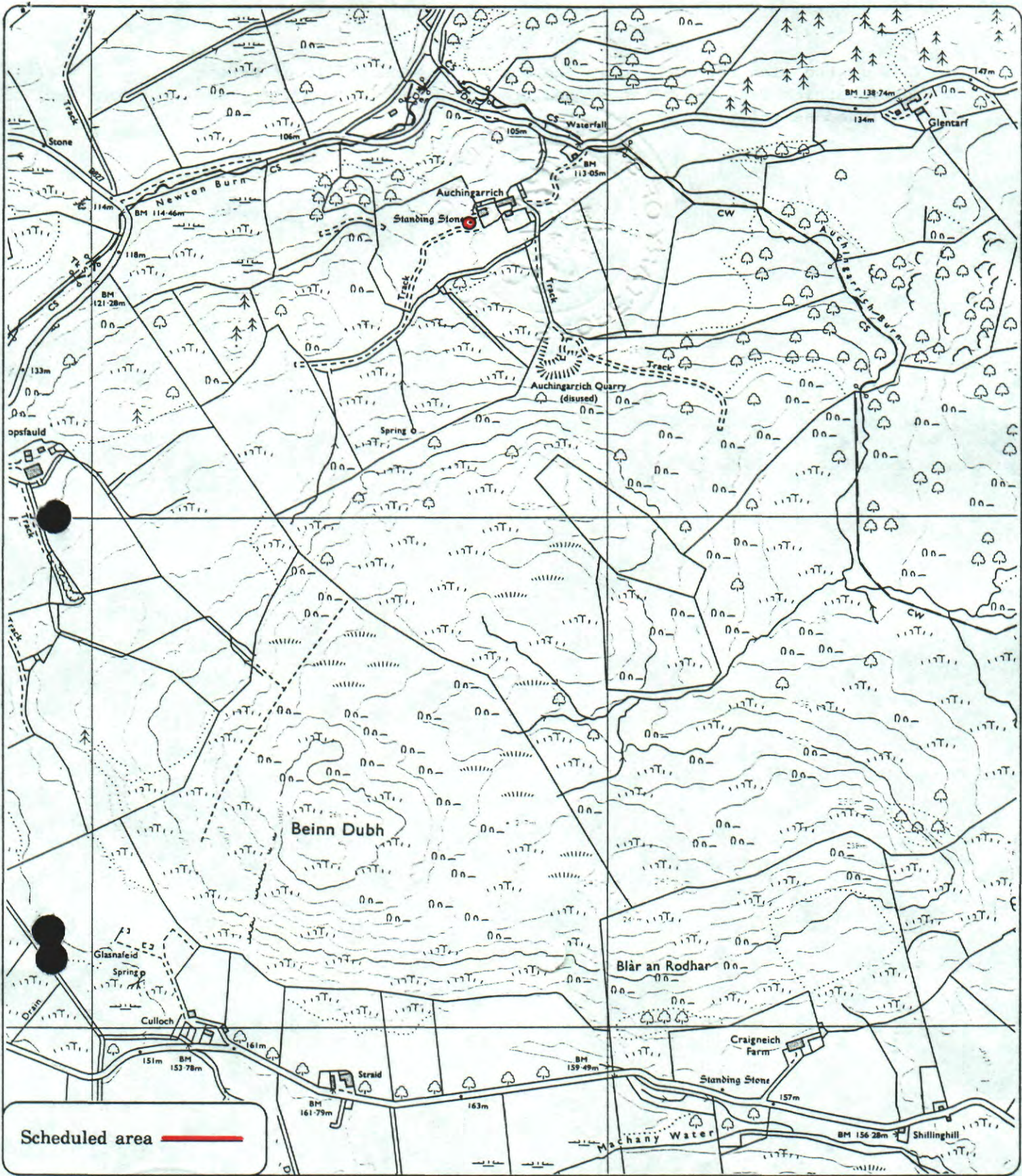

Scheduled area

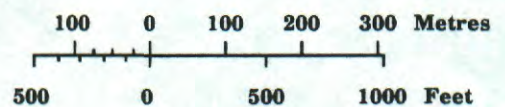
Auchingarrich Farm, standing stone, Comrie
