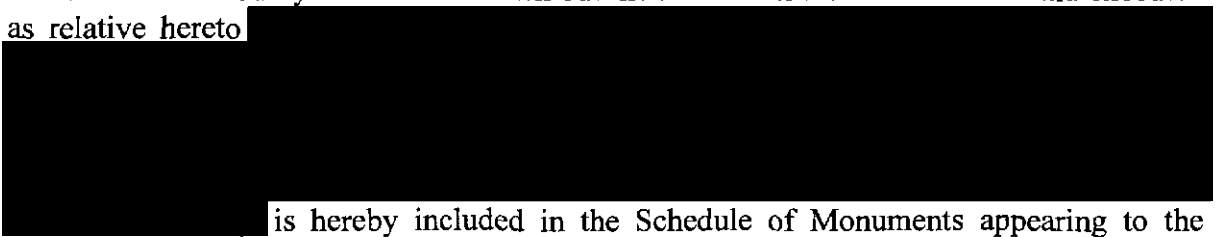

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Clach Ossian, standing stone and enclosure comprises a standing stone and enclosure of prehistoric date, the latter surviving as a turf-covered earthwork. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible remains and an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is D-shaped with maximum dimensions of 40m NE-SW by 30m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Fowlis Wester and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

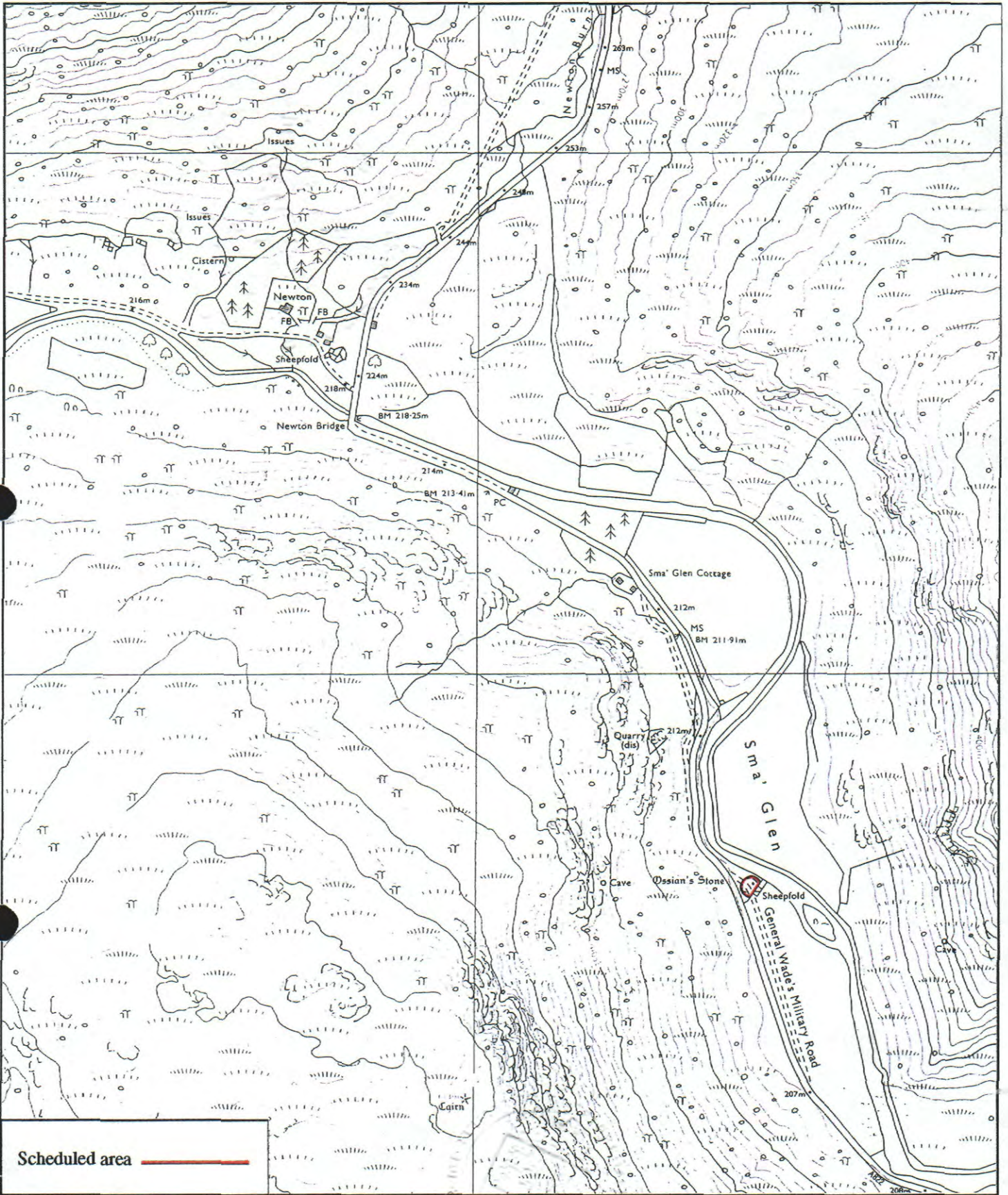

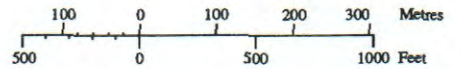
**Clach Ossian, standing stone and enclosure**
