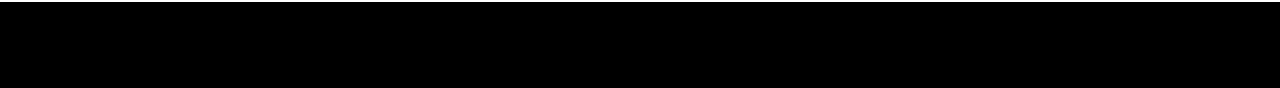

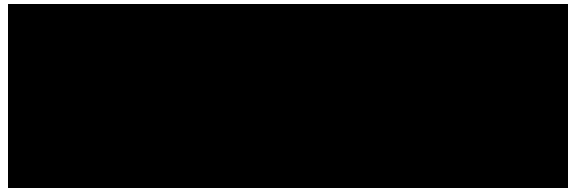
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Keir Estate

situated in the Parish of Kilmadock and County of Perth



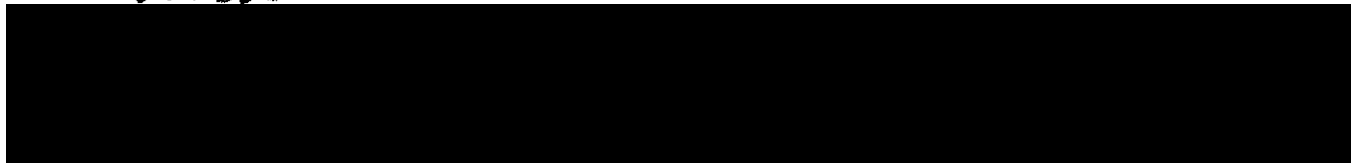
