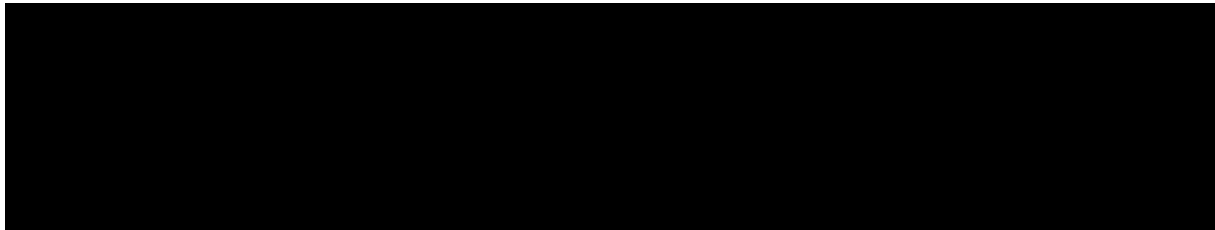

The area to be scheduled is a circle 40m in diameter which includes the stone circle and an area around it in which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive.  is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

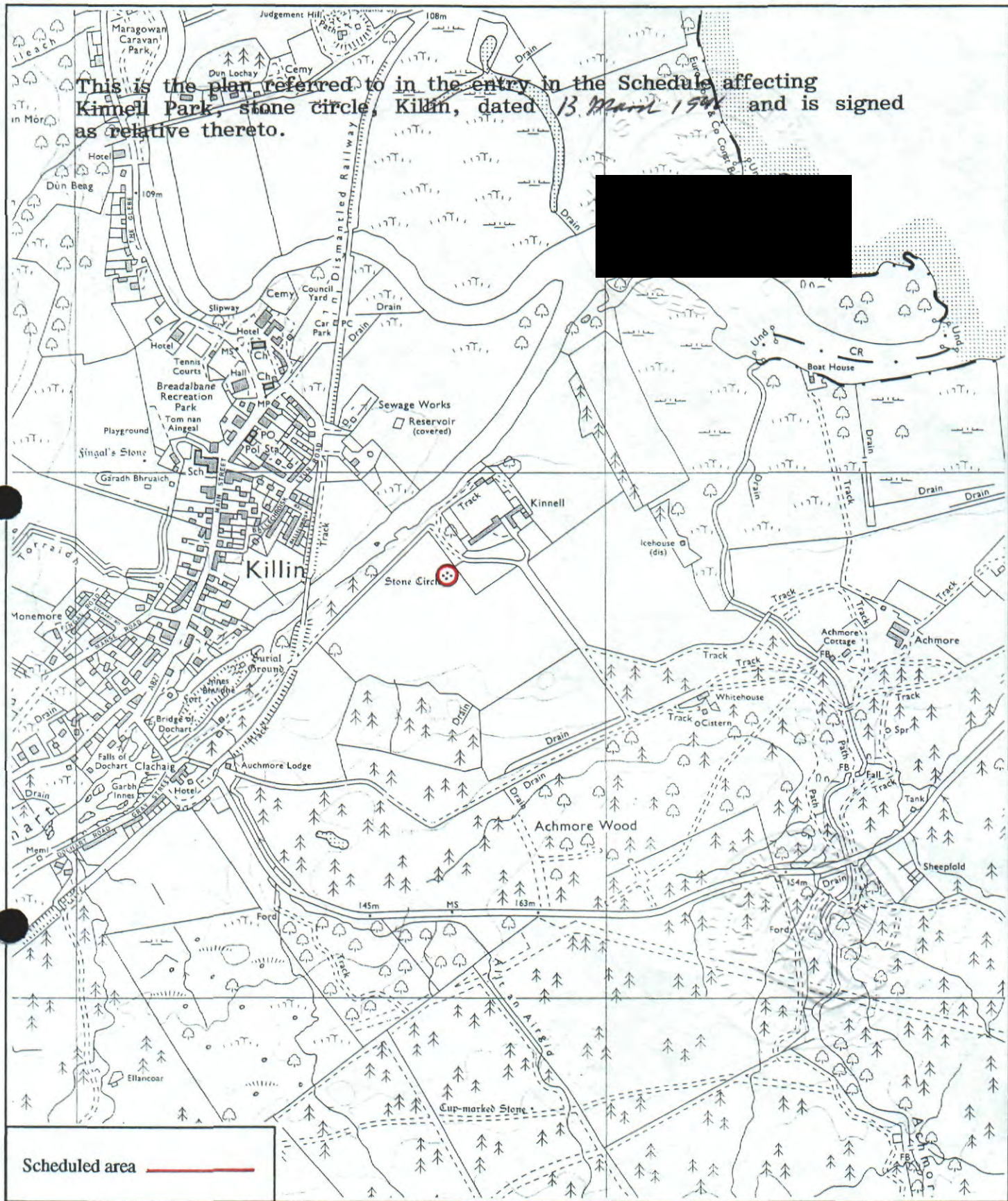

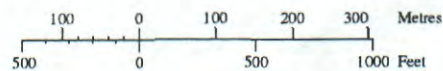
Kinnell Park, stone circle, Killin
