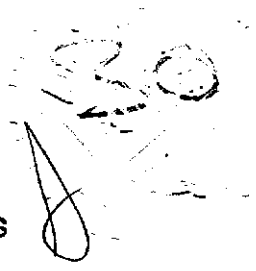

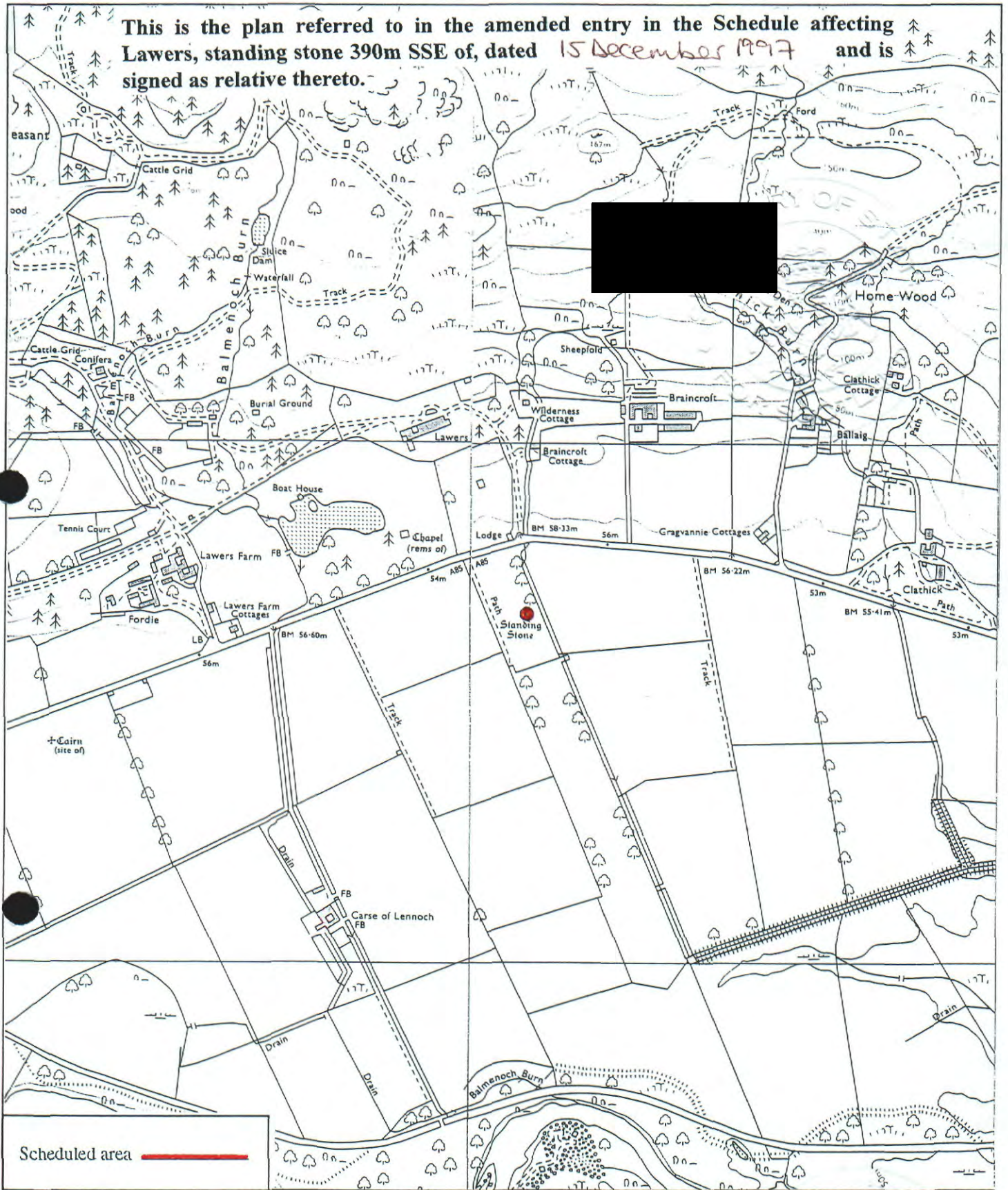

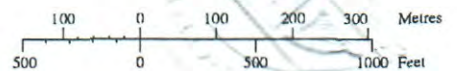


Lawers, standing stone 390m SSE of
