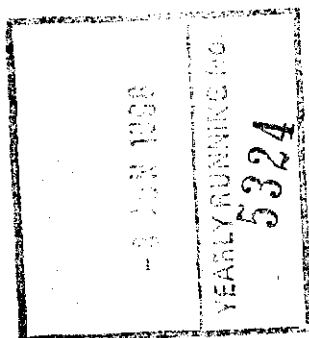

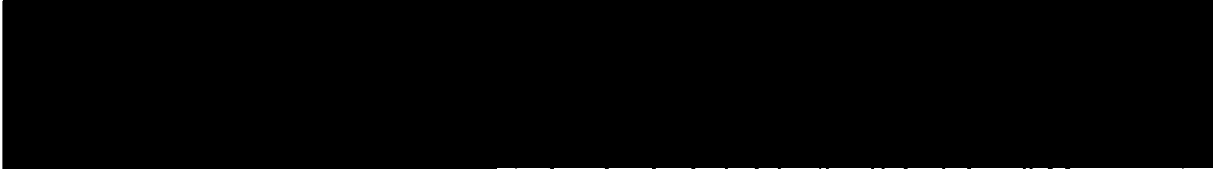

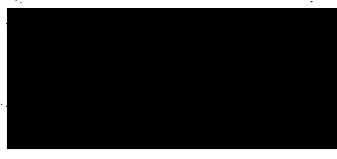
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Na Clachan Aoraidh, stone circle 1850m WSW of Edintian comprises a stone circle of prehistoric date, visible as a group of upright and prostrate stones. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 50m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Blair Atholl and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

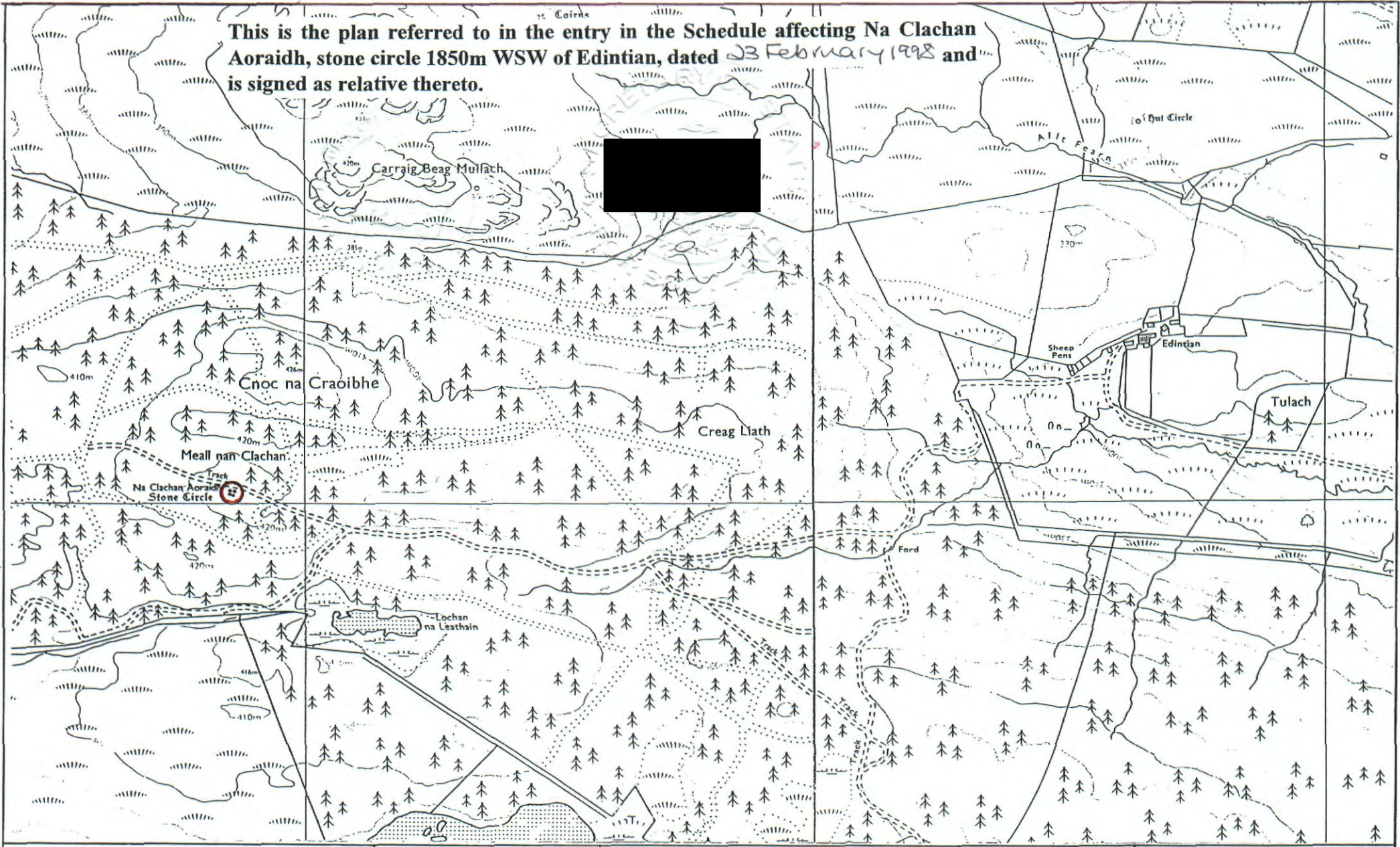

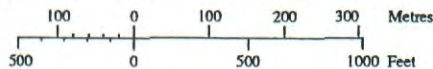
Na Clachan Aoraidh, stone circle
