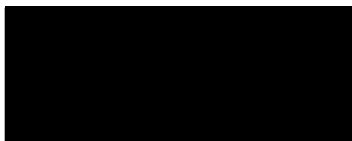

The monument known as Pitcrocknie, standing stone 400m W of comprises a standing stone of Neolithic or Bronze Age date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the standing stone and an area around it in which traces of associated ritual activity may be expected to survive. It is circular with a diameter of 20m. 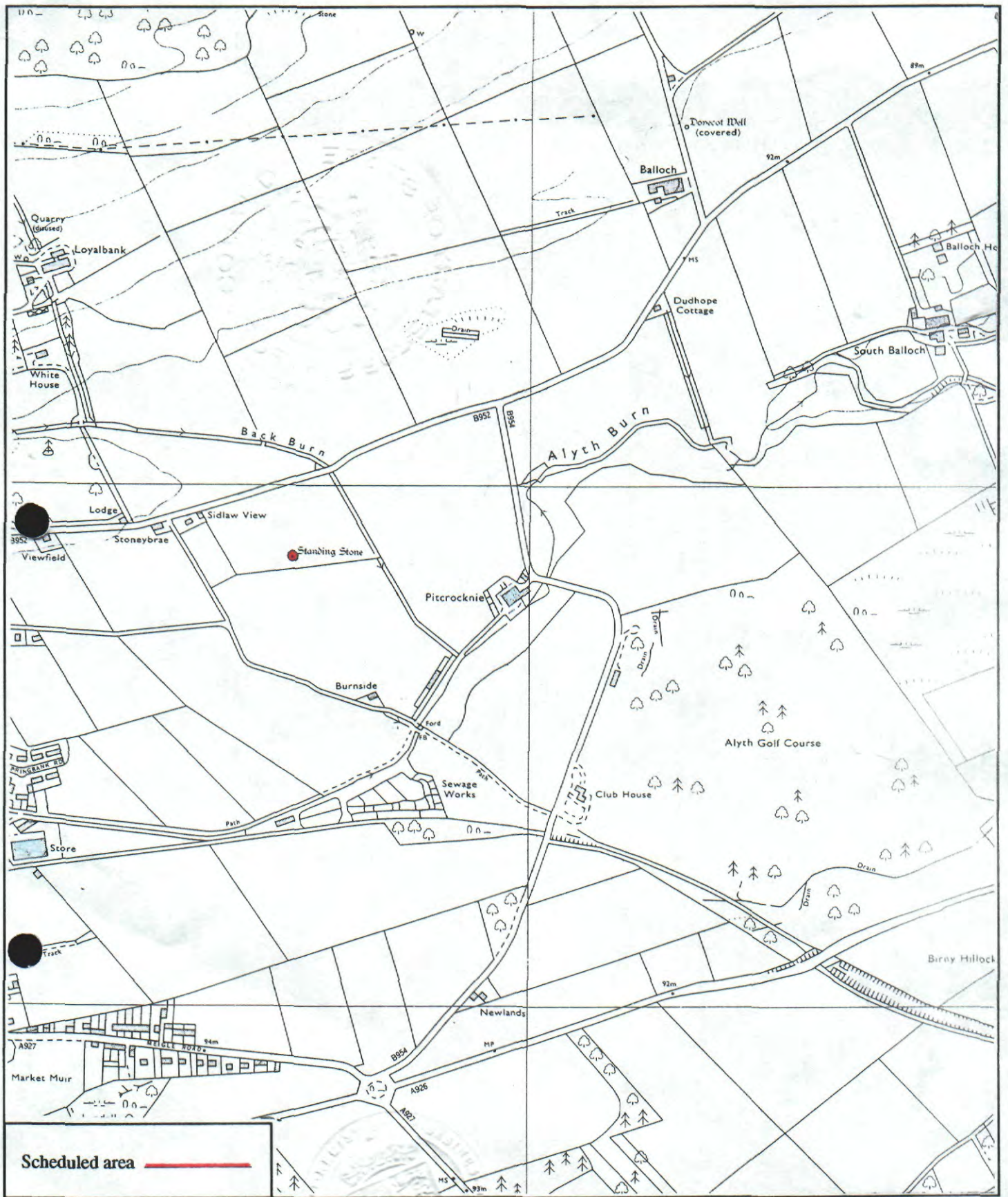

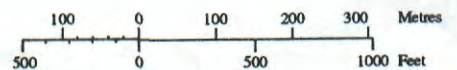
**Pitcrocknie, standing stone 400m W
