THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Barry Hill, fort comprises the remains of a multi-phase hillfort of Iron Age date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the fort and an area around it in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 310m E-W by 210m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Alyth and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the Disposition by David Lyulph Gore Wolseley Ogilvy, Earl of Airlie in favour of Charles William Fergusson dated 20 July and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Perth on 1 August both in the year 1923 (the present owners whereof being John Alexander Adamson, Buchal Farm, by Alyth and David Grant Adamson, The Garrett, Bankhead, by Alyth), is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

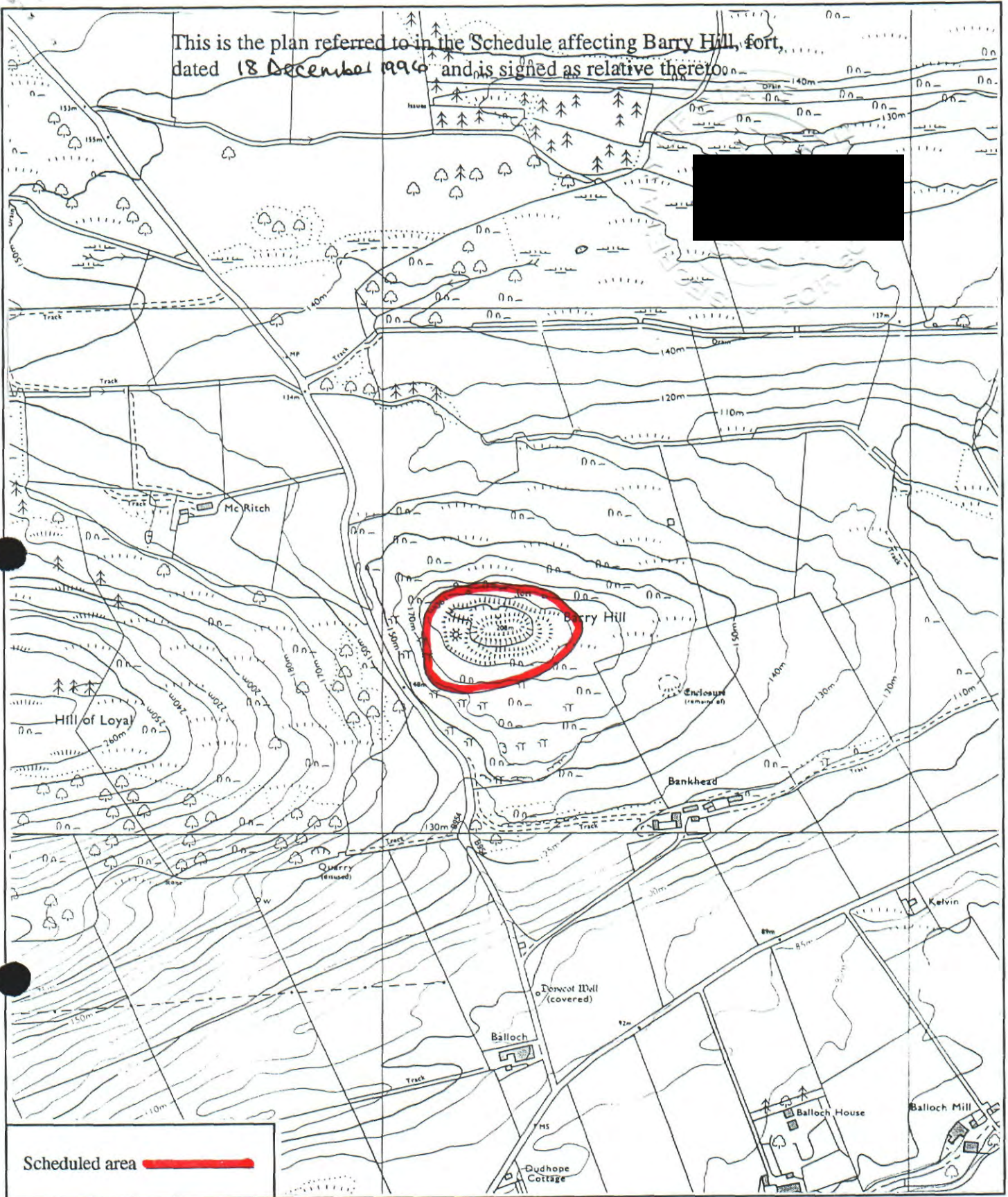

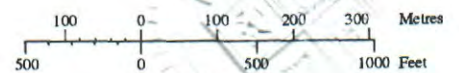
Barry Hill, fort
