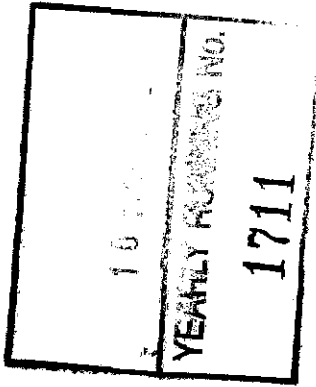

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Meikle Obney, standing stone 260m E of comprises a standing stone of prehistoric date, visible as an upstanding monument. The monument which is a massive block of schist known locally at the 'Witch's Stone', stands just over 2m high and has a girth of c.3.5m around its base, lies about 260m E of Meikle Obney, at around 145m OD. The area to be scheduled includes the standing stone and an area around it within which related material may be expected to survive. It is almost semi-circular, truncated by the boundary fence adjacent to the road. It has maximum dimensions of 10m NW-SE by 6m transversely. The boundary fence is excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Auchtergaven and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

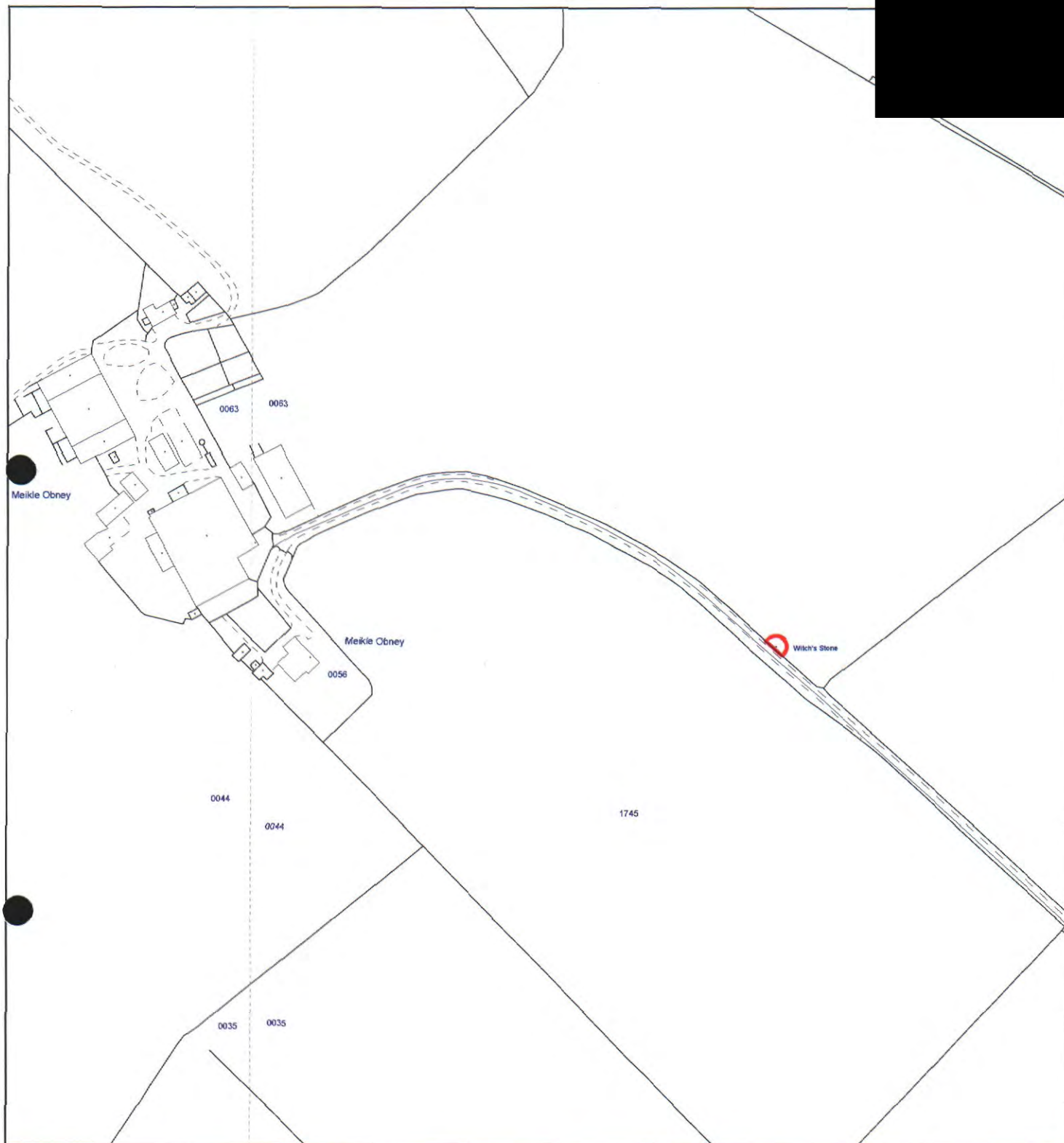
