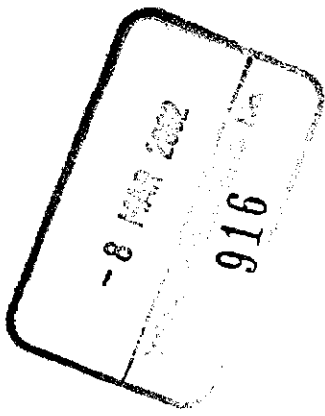

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Coldoch, broch comprises the remains of a broch, a circular drystone structure dating from the Iron Age. The monument, which is a rare example of a lowland Scottish Broch, is situated in mixed woodland about 300m to the WSW of Coldoch House. The broch is almost 9m in diameter with a massive drystone wall. The entrance passageway lies on the ENE part of the circuit; remains of a stairway can be seen immediately adjacent to the ESE; and there are three intramural chambers with square angles, on the SSW, WNW and NNE parts of the circuit respectively. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to survive. It is circular and measures a maximum of 30m in diameter. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kincardine (Stirling) and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and
