the owners of the Monument known as the ruined Gatehouse, part of the remains of Coupar Angus Abbey, contained within a railed enclosure on the north-east side of Queen Street in the Burgh of Coupar Angus directly opposite the junction of said Street with the approach road to Abbey House and Abbeyhill situated said Gatehouse, 215 feet or thereby south-south-east of the south west corner of the Abbey Church of Coupar Angus, 320 feet or thereby south-east by south of the junction of the south-west side of Queen Street with the south-east side of Precinct Street and 110 feet or thereby north-east of the northmost corner of the building situated on the south-west side of Queen Street and now or formerly known as the South United Free Church Manse.

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands and Barony of Coupar or Coupar Angus

situated in the Parish of Coupar Angus and  
County of ~~Forfar~~ formerly of Forfar and now of Perth.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
