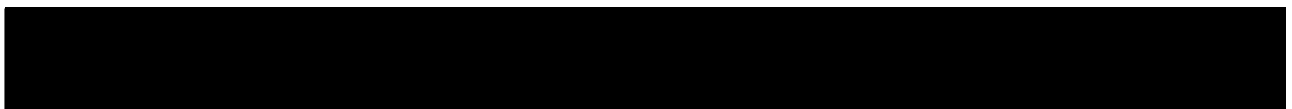

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.


~~the owner~~ of the Monument known as Saint Bride's Church or Blair Church consisting of (first) the Church contained within a rectangular area of ground measuring 65 feet on each of its north and south sides and 20 feet on each of its east and west sides and (second) the vault contained within an area of ground bounded on the north by said Church and measuring 15 feet on each of its north, east, south and west sides; the south-east corner of said (first) area of ground being situated 130 yards east of the Banvie Burn at its nearest point, 100 yards south by west of the south-east corner of the eastmost buildings at Old Blair and 310 yards north-east by north of the north-east end of the north parapet of the bridge carrying the main Avenue to Blair Castle over said burn,

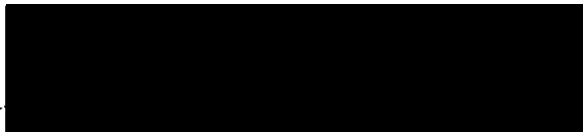
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Atholl Estates

situated in the Parish of Blair Atholl and
County of Perth.

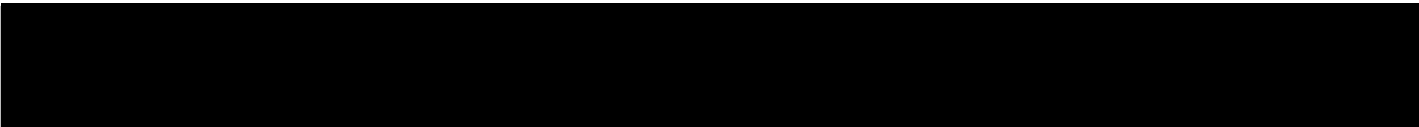

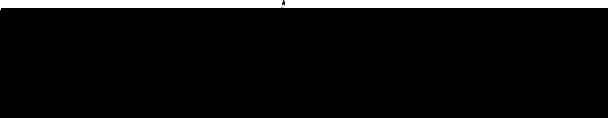
