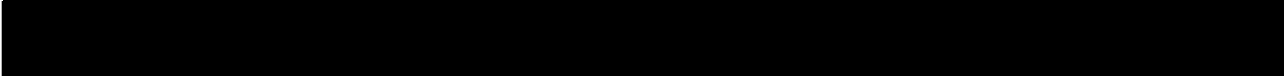

the owner of the Monument known as Kinclaven Castle (in ruins) occupying an area of ground on the west or right bank of the River Tay measuring 130 feet square, the eastmost corner of said area being situated 130 feet north-west by west of said river bank at its nearest point, 380 feet west by north of the junction of the boundaries between the parishes of Kinclaven, Caputh and Cargill, which is coincident with the junction of the media fila of said River and the River Isla, and 890 feet south by west of the south-west end of Kinclaven Bridge,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Kinclaven Estate

situated in the Parish of Kinclaven and
County of Perth.


In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

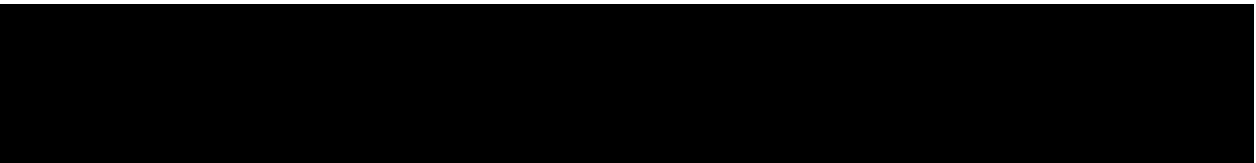

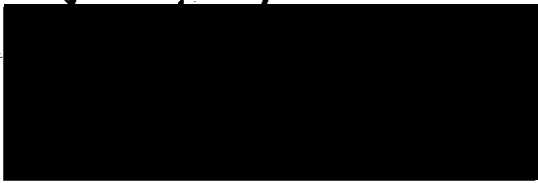

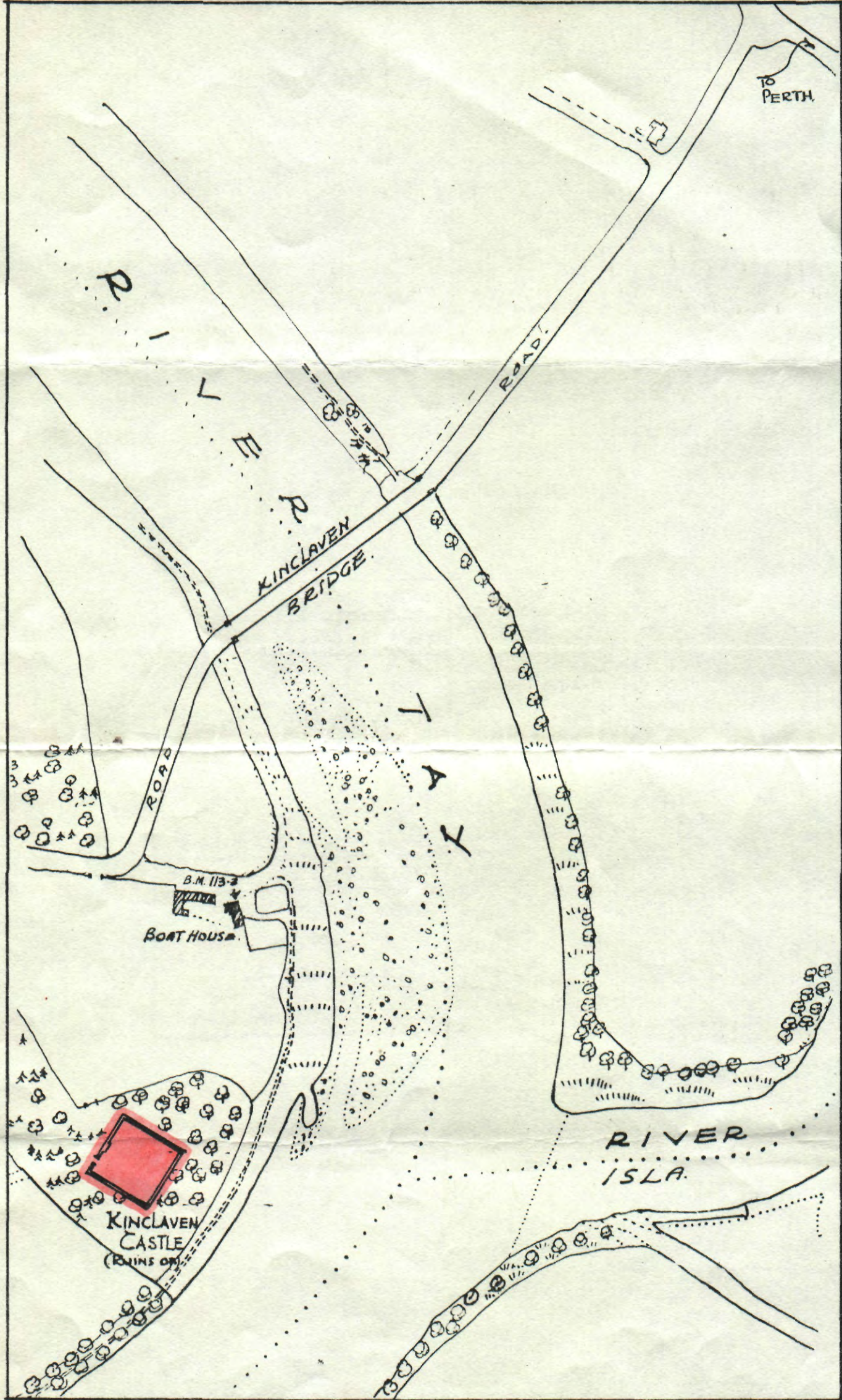
