

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 1650
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Barr Castle comprises the remains of Barr Castle, a late medieval tower house first constructed in the early 16th century. It is visible as the ruins of the tower and surrounding areas of grass-covered rubble. The area to be scheduled is approximately rectangular on plan, to include the remains described and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment may survive. The area to be scheduled specifically excludes the above-ground elements of the post-and-wire fence surrounding the tower to allow for its maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lochwinnoch and the County of Renfrew as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

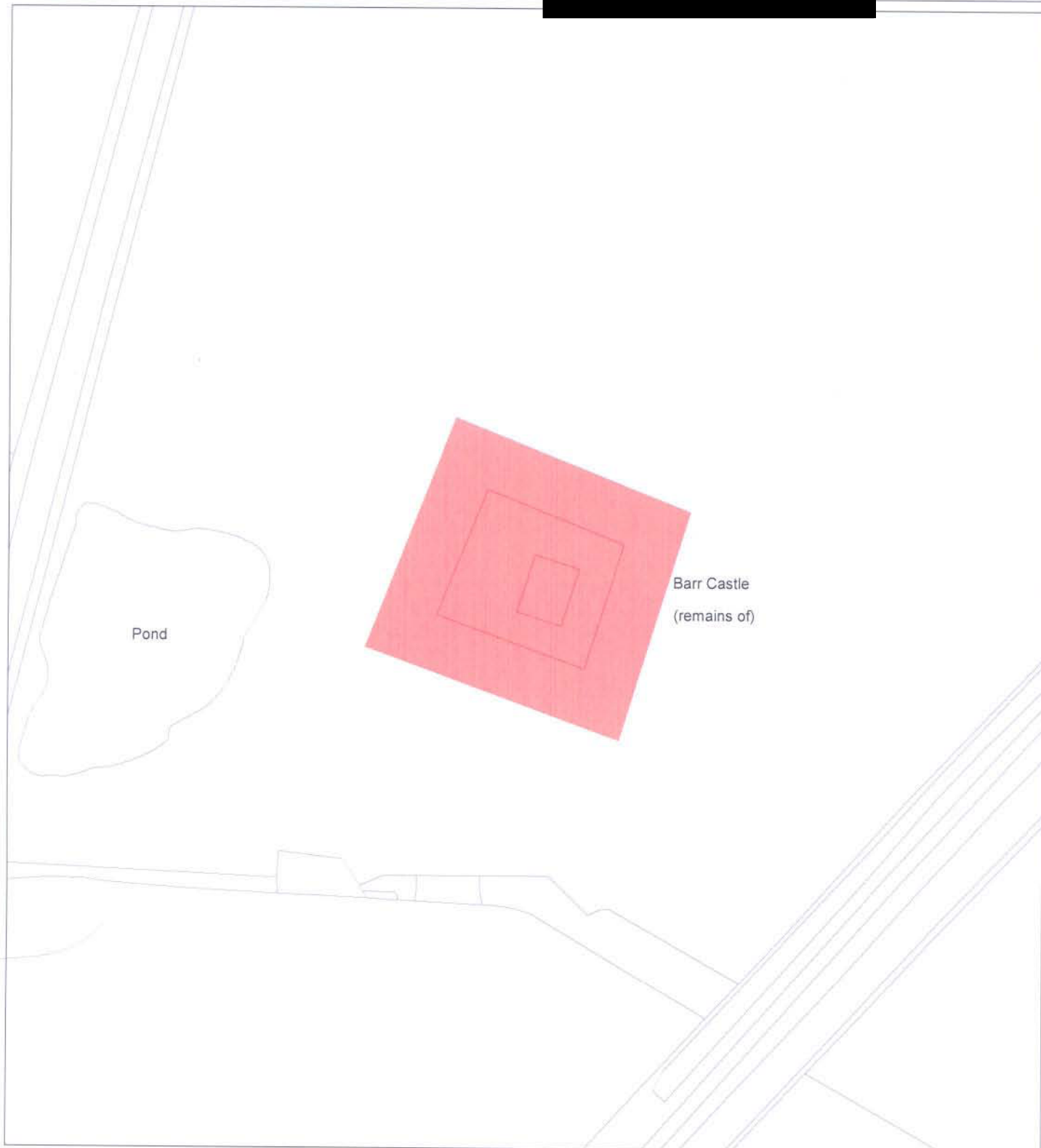
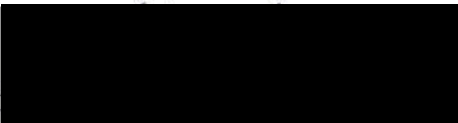
