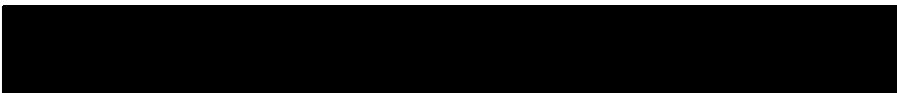

the owners of the Monument known as "Dun Borve" (broch) situated on Blàr an Duin, 950 yards north-north-west of the point where the public road from Port of Ness to Bail' Ard and Borve crosses the Grundale Burn 1800 yards north-north-east of Bail' Ard Smithy, Lewis, and 370 yards east-south-east from the seashore at its nearest point,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as South Galson Farm

situated in the Parish of Barvas and County of Ross and Cromarty.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

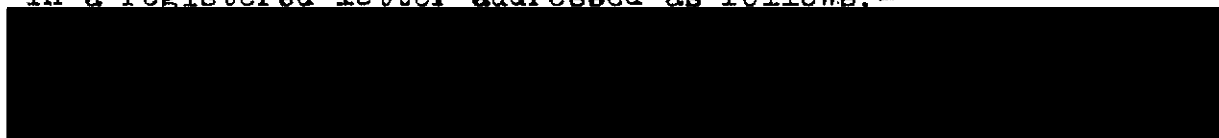

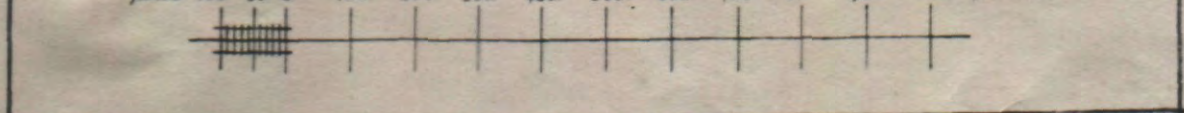
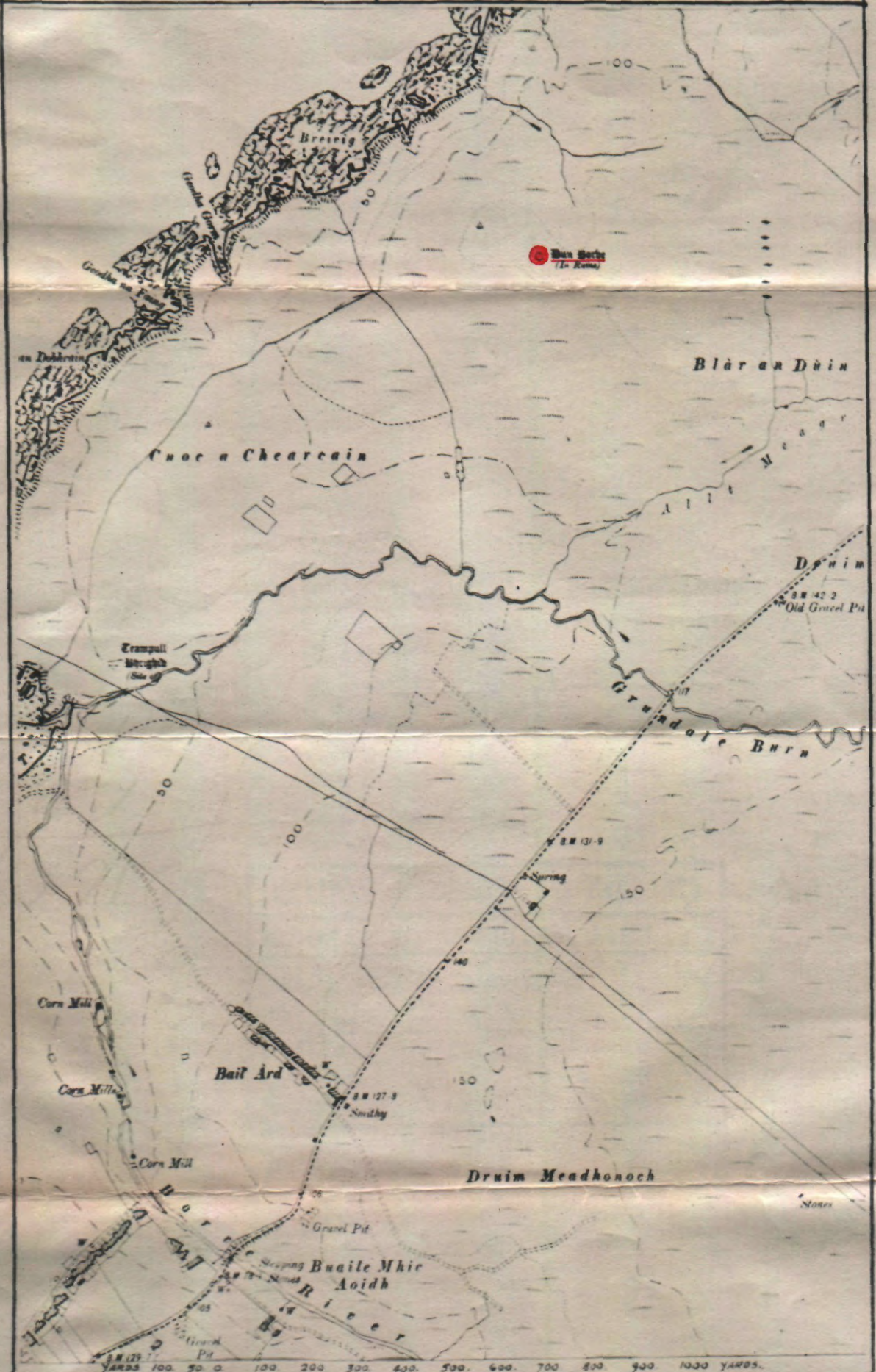
