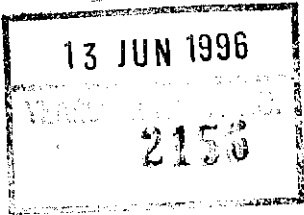

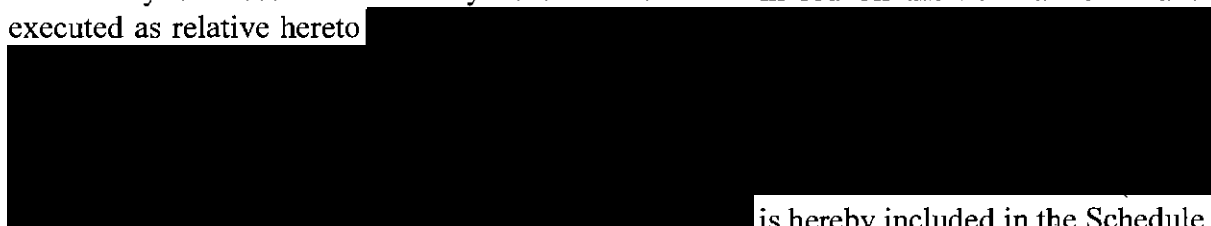

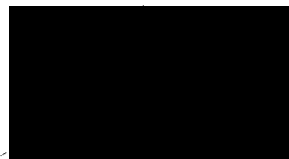
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Clach a'Charridh, cross slab (Shandwick Stone) comprises an upright slab of sandstone, carved on both sides. The area to be scheduled consists of a circle 10m in diameter, centred on the stone. It includes the stone and an area of ground which, although it has been partly excavated, contains evidence for the methods used to erect and support the stone. The scheduling is to exclude the above-ground structure of the shelter constructed around the stone. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Nigg and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

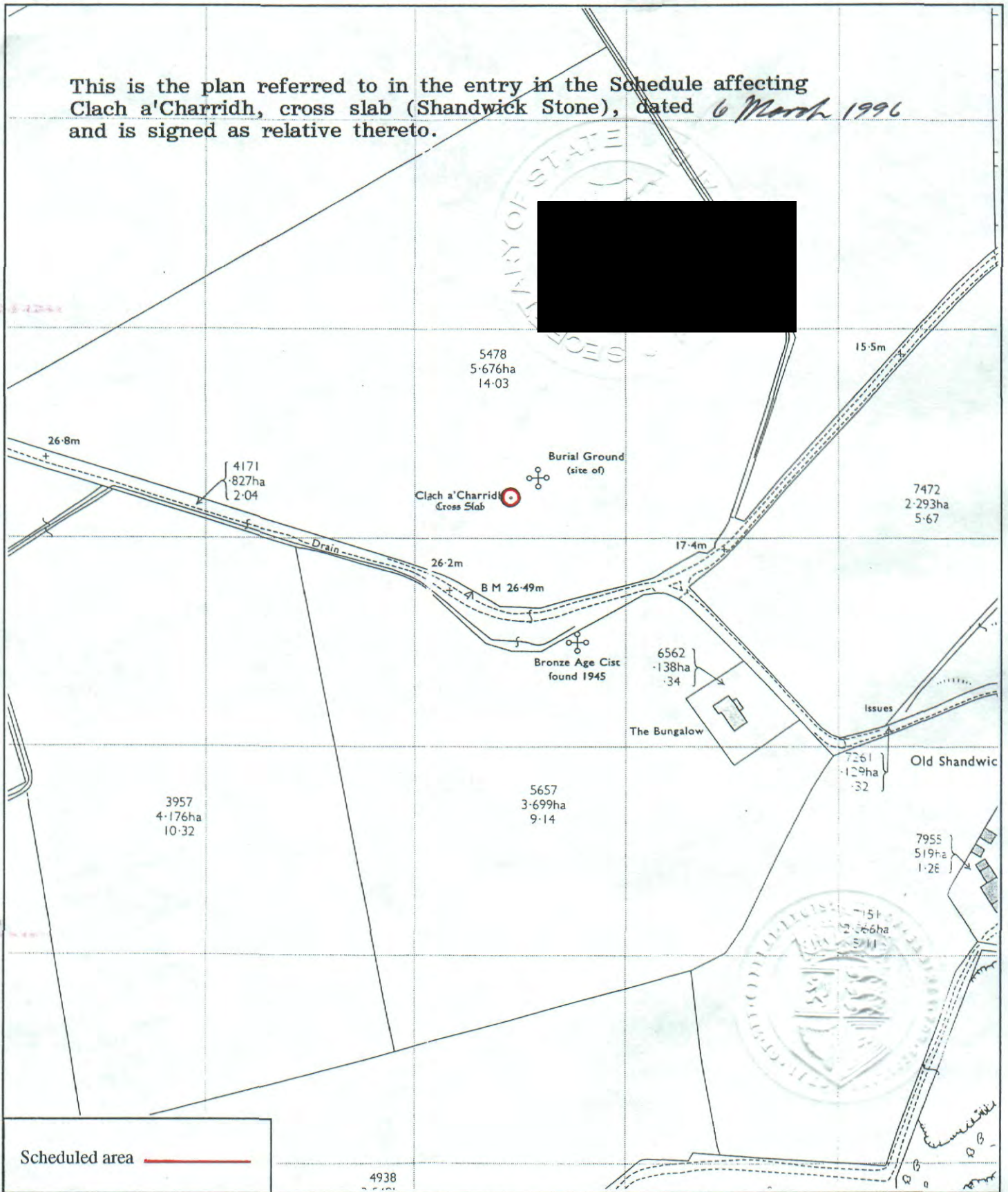

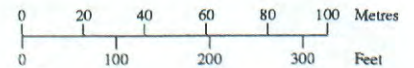
Clach a' Charridh, cross slab
