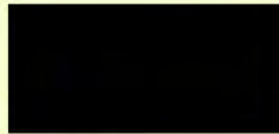


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Chapel of Ui or Old Kirk of Eye, dated and in respect of which three notices were served on 11 March 1954 and which notices were recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Ross and Cromarty on 19 April 1954 [Lib. 355 Folios 205, 208 and 211 respectively] and now to be known as St Columba's Church, Aiginis, Uidh, is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as comprising of a rectangular area of ground measuring some 37m SW-NE by 15m SE-NW, including the church, the burial aisle, the tombstones and an area of ground extending 4m from the church on all sides, as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

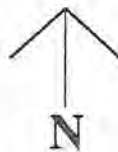

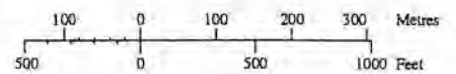
St Columba's Church, Aiginis, Uidh

the owners of the Monument known as Chapel of Ui or Old Kirk of Eye contained within a rectangular area of ground measuring 90 feet on each of its north by west and south by east sides and 20 feet on each of its east by north and west by south sides, the south-westmost point of said area being situated 90 feet east of the High Water Mark at its nearest point on the north shore of the Eye Peninsula, 890 feet north-north-west by north of Bench Mark 20.9 on the north side of the public road from Stornoway to Knock and 1,700 feet west-north-west of Bench Mark 20.8 on the south side of said public road

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as **The Chapel of Ui,**

situated in the Parish of **Stornoway** and County of **Ross and Cromarty.**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

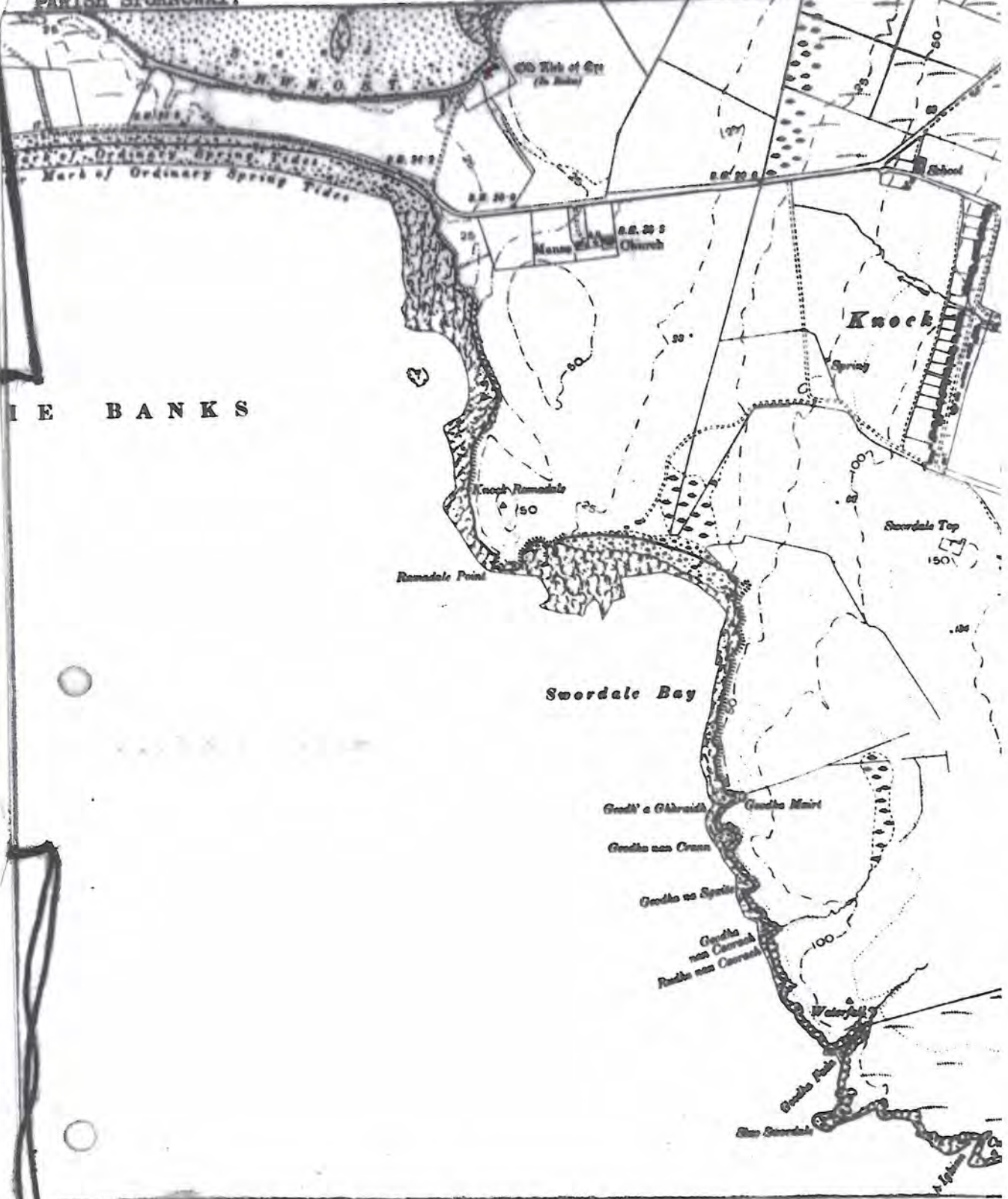
