the owner of the Monument known as The Fort and Hut Circles contained within the oval area of ground on the summit of Carby Hill measuring 120 yards at its greatest length from north by east to south by west and 90 yards at its greatest width from east by south to west by north, the southmost point of said area being situated 1,240 yards north-west by north of the Bench Mark 523.4 on the north side of the road running in a general north-west direction from Kershope Bridge, 1,570 yards north-west of said bridge and 270 yards west by south of the source of the Couper Cleuch Burn

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm and Lands of Sorbietrees

situated in the Parish of Castleton and
County of Roxburgh

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
