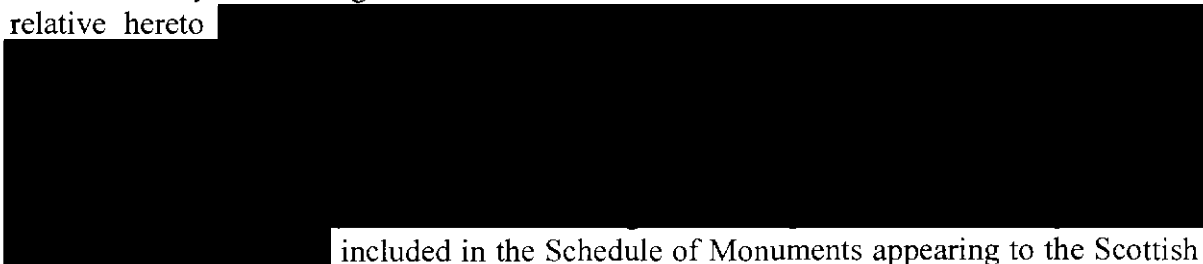

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cessford Castle comprises a massively built L-shaped tower house, within a courtyard of which traces of the walls and earthworks survive. Beyond that main nucleus are traces of further earthworks, which are probably the relics of outer courtyards. Amongst these may be traces of earthen siegeworks constructed in 1523. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, with maximum dimensions of c.125m from north to south and 239m from east to west. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Eckford and the County of Roxburgh as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

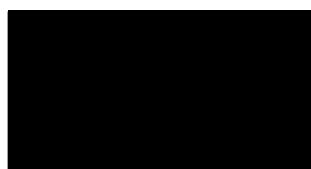

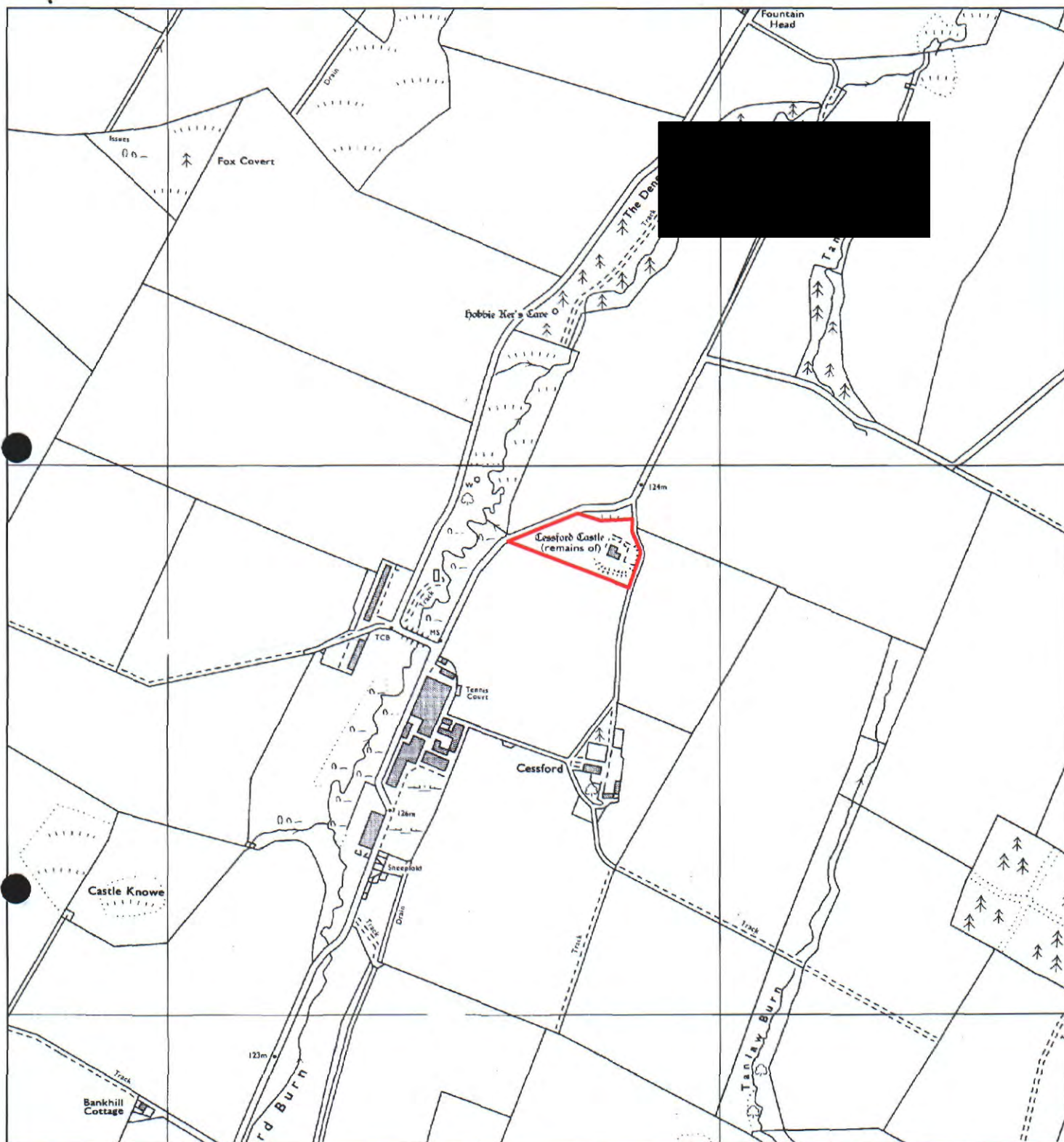
