the owners of the monument known as Liddel Castle contained within an area of ground bounded on the north-west by the Liddel Water and on the east by a stream flowing through Kirk Cleuch and having a maximum length from north-north-east to south-south-west of 500 ft. and a maximum width from east to west of 450 ft. the westmost point of said area being situated on the south-east or left bank of said Water; 420 ft. north-north-west of the road between Jedburgh and Newcastleton at its nearest point; 630 ft. west-north-west of the point where said road crosses said stream and 800 ft. north-north-east of the milestone on said road two miles from Newcastleton,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm and Lands of Castleton

situated in the Parish of Castleton
County of Roxburgh.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
