the owner of the Monument known as Timpendean Tower and Earth Works contained within an irregular area of ground lying to the north-east of the village of Lanton and to the north-west of Lanton Moor bounded on the north-west by a field dyke along which it extends 175 yards or thereby; on the north-east partly by a plantation and partly by open ground containing a stream flowing north-eastwards past Timpendean Cottages to the River Teviot along which it extends 175 yards or thereby; on the south-east by a wall or dyke forming the north-west boundary of a field immediately to the north-west of the plantations of Lanton Moor along which it extends 160 yards or thereby; and on the south-west by another wall or dyke along which it extends following the curve 175 yards or thereby,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands and Estate of Monteviot

situated in the Parish of Jedburgh and
County of Roxburgh.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
