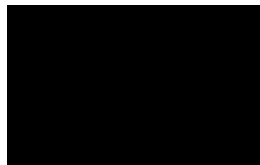
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as parts of Buccleuch Estates and others

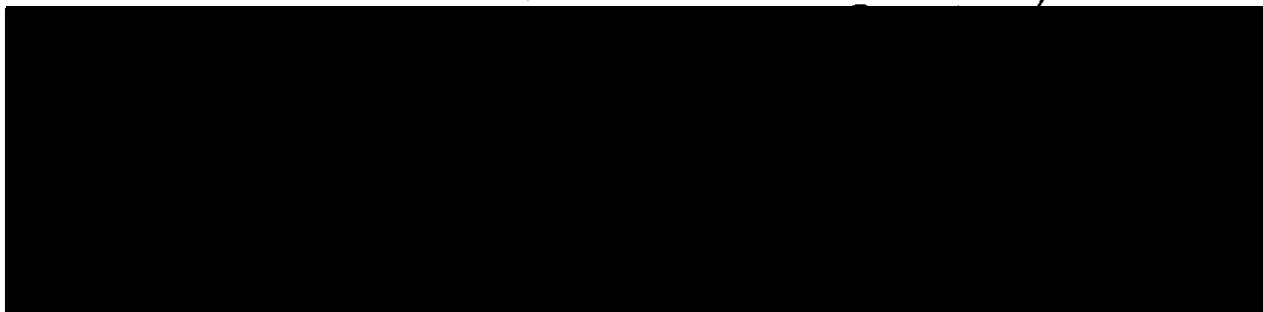
