IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

[Redacted], the owners of the Monument known as Newark Castle (in ruins) contained within a quadrilateral area of ground measuring from its north-eastmost point to its south-eastmost point 60 yards in a south direction, from its south-eastmost point to its south-westmost point 70 yards in a west by north direction, from its south-westmost point to its north-westmost point 40 yards in a north direction and from its north-westmost point to its north-eastmost point 70 yards in an east by north direction, said north-eastmost point being situated 90 yards west by south of the south-westmost corner of the southmost building at Newarkmill, 110 yards south by west of the Yarrow Water at its nearest point and 140 yards north-north-west of the north-west corner of the northmost building at Newark, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Bowhill Estate situated in the Parish and County of Selkirk.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

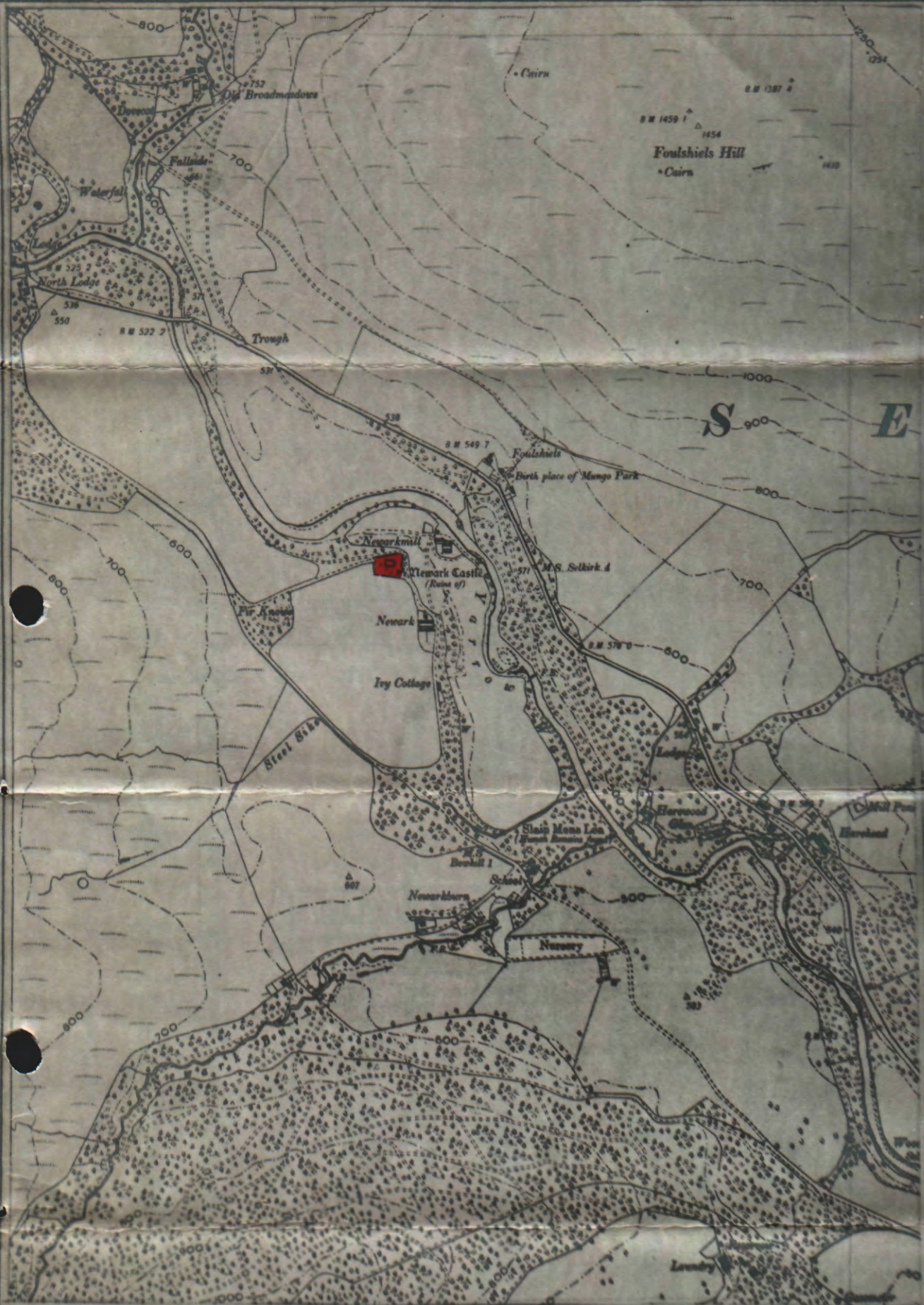
