the owner of the Monuments known as two Broughs (or Brochs) in the Strath of Kildonan consisting of (First) the Brough (or Broch) with ditches and ramparts occupying a circular area of ground measuring one hundred and twenty yards in diameter, the westmost point of said area being situated four hundred and ten yards south-east of the Allt Cille Pheadair at its nearest point, four hundred and eighty yards north-north-east at its nearest point of the road between Helmsdale and Kinbrace and five hundred and fifty yards north-east by east of the Bench Mark one hundred and thirteen point four on the north parapet of the bridge carrying said road over said Allt Cille Pheadair and (Second) the Brough (or Broch) occupying a circular area of ground measuring thirty yards in diameter on the left or west bank of the Eldrable Burn, the northmost point of said area being situated one hundred and ninety yards south by east of Highland Railway now the London Midland and Scottish Railway up Strath Ullie at its nearest point and two hundred and eighty yards south-west by west of the south-west corner of Eldrable, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands and Estate of Torrish and others situated in the Parish of Kildonan and County of Sutherland.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monuments above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
