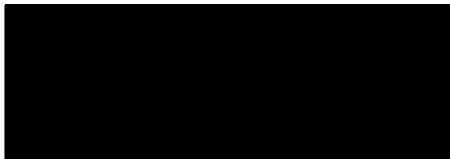

AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Cairn Buy ESE of Green House Bridge, as described (FIRST) in the Certificate of Service of Notice by the Minister of Works dated 4 August 1953 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Wigtown on 8 October 1954 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the monument now known as Cairn Buy, cairn 720m NW of Garheugh and the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 34m NS by 35m EW to include the cairn and ground around it in which traces of activities associated with its construction and use may survive as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

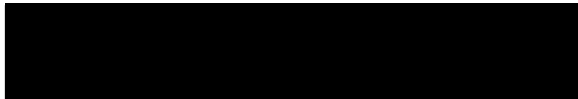
