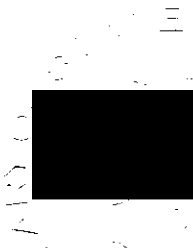
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cairn Pat, or Piot, fort comprises a hillfort of Iron Age date, surmounting a prominent hill. The area to be scheduled is an irregular oval measuring 190m N-S by 175m E-W, to include the entire hilltop. Specifically excluded from scheduling are the above-ground structures of the two transmission masts and associated buildings and access road as they exist at the date of re-scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Portpatrick and the County of Wigtown as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

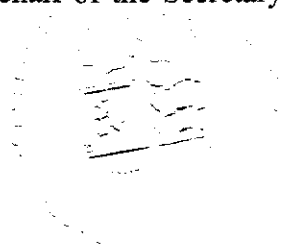

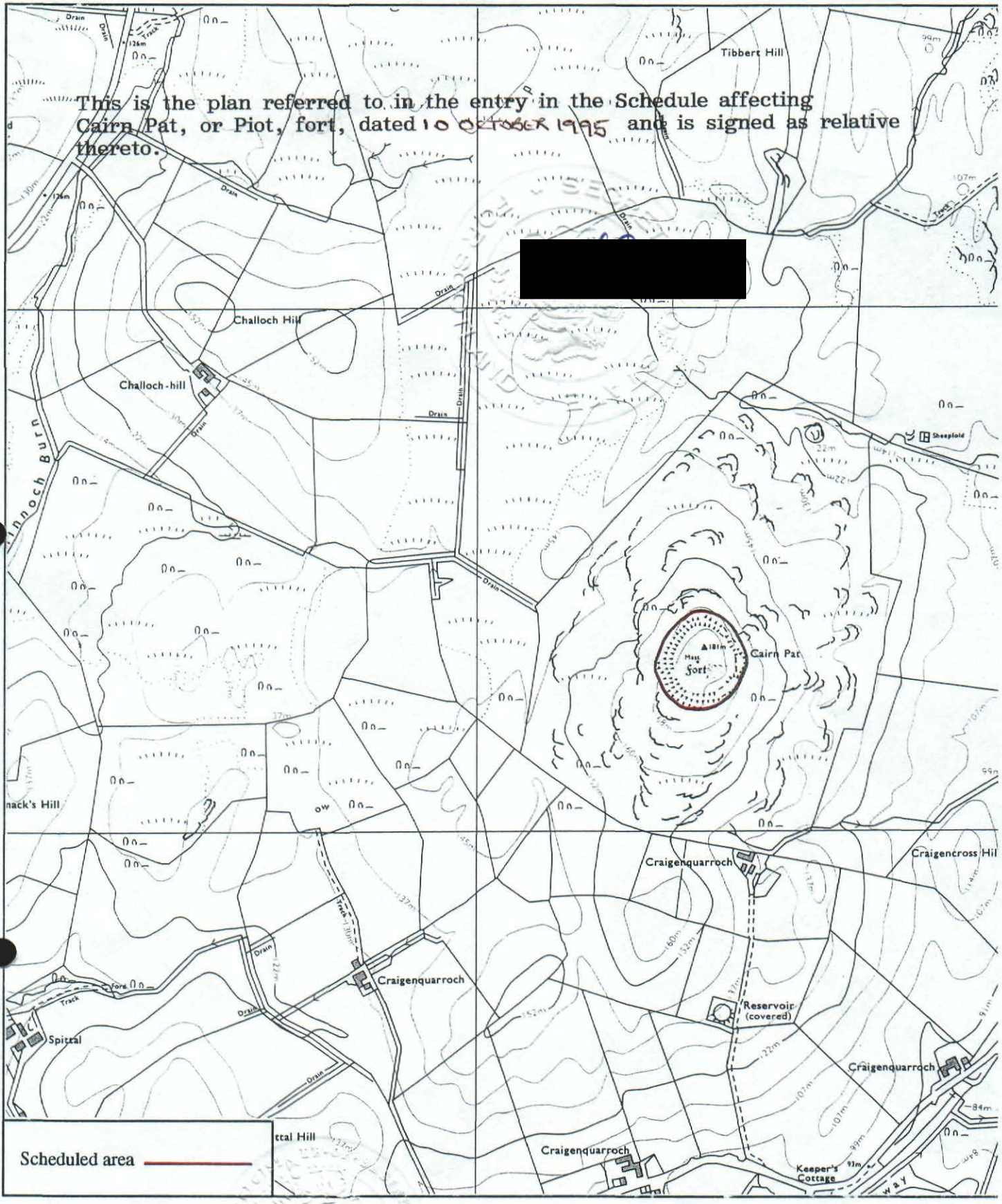

Scheduled area ———

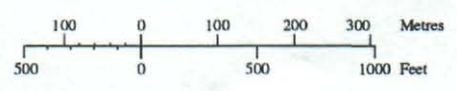
Cairn Pat, or Piot, fort
