IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

the owner of the Monument known as "Castle Ban" (fort) occupying an oval area of ground measuring 100 yards at its greatest length from east by north to west by south and 70 yards at its greatest width from south by east to north by west. the westmost point of said area being situated 20 yards north-east of high water mark at its nearest point on the west shore of the Rhinns of Galloway to the south of Castle Butt, 1040 yards west by north of the south-west corner of the main block of farm buildings at Mains of Airies and 960 yards south by west of the point where the Dally Burn enters said high water mark,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm of Mains of Airies

situated in the Parish of Kirkcolm

and

County of Wigtown.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
