of the Monument known as the Fort occupying an irregular area of ground on  
a promontory between Camp Bay South and Grey Hen Bay bounded on the  
north-north-east by a fence or dyke forming the south boundary of arable land  
immediately to the south of Kirklauchlane farm buildings along which it  
extends Eighty yards, on the east-south-east and east by the edge of the  
cliff on the west side of Grey Hen Bay along which it extends One hundred  
and fifty yards, on the south-west, west and south by the cliff edge between  
said Bays along which it extends One hundred and sixty yards and on the north  
and north-west by a small stream flowing south-westwards into said Camp Bay  
along which it extends One hundred and twenty yards,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of  
the property known as the Farm and lands of Kirklauchline  
situated in the Parish of Stoneykirk and  
County of Wigtown.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments  
Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings  
hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above  
specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the  
Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

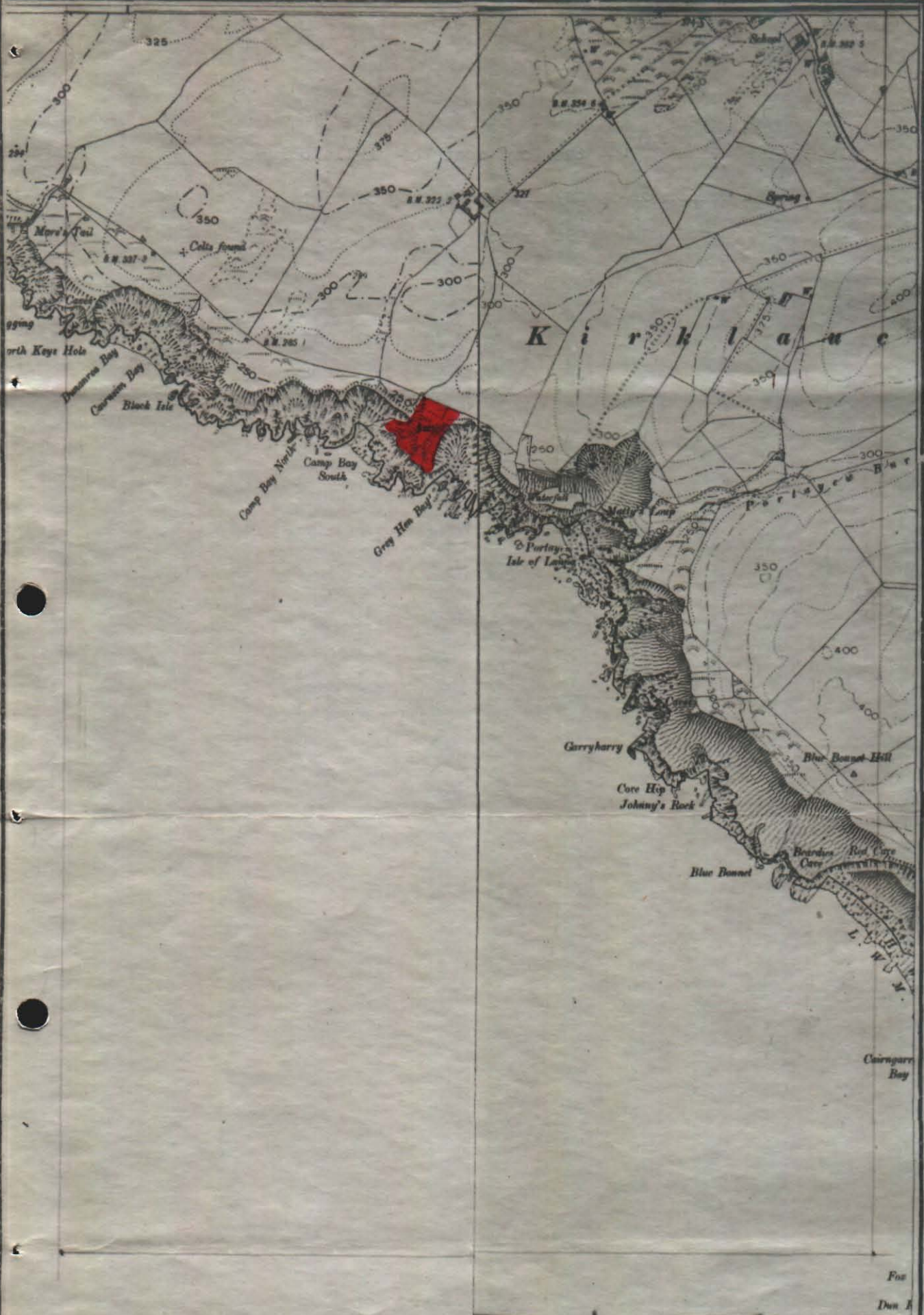
