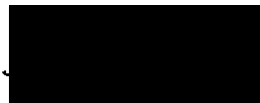

AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Laggan Fort now to be known as Laggan, fort, Carleton, dated 29 December 1950 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Wigtown on 26 January 1951 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring a maximum of 120m ENE-WSW by 100m NW-SE, to include the fort, its outer defences and a small area around it in which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

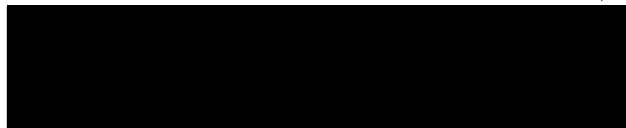

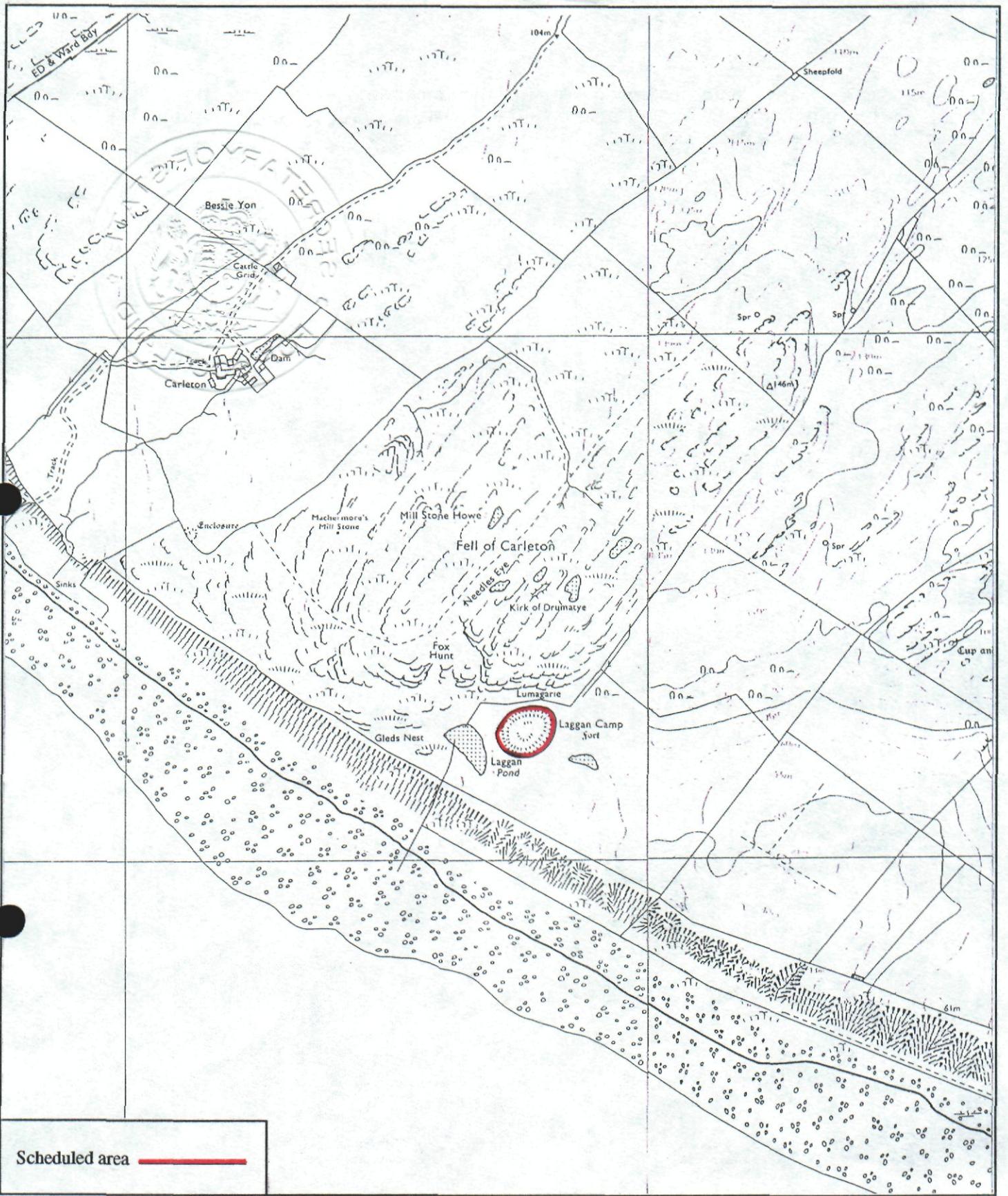




Scheduled area ———
