[redacted] owners or otherwise of the Monument known as Portpatrick Old Parish Kirk (in ruins) situated within the Kirkyard at Portpatrick, the south-westmost corner of said Kirk being situated fifty yards north-west of Main Street at its nearest point, ninety yards north by east of the Bench Mark 19.2 on the corner of the buildings formed by the junction of the north side of North Crescent with the north-west side of Main Street and one hundred yards north-east by east of the junction of the north side of North Crescent with the east side of Blair Street,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Portpatrick Old Parish Burying Ground

situated in the Parish of Portpatrick and County of Wigtown.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

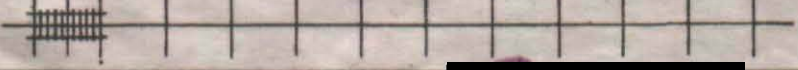
