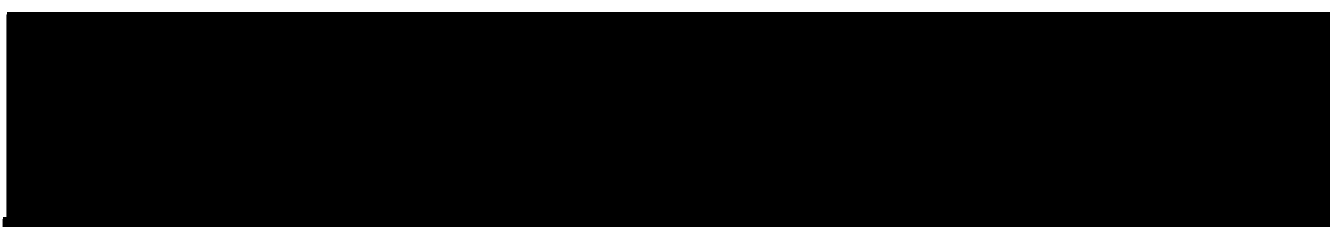

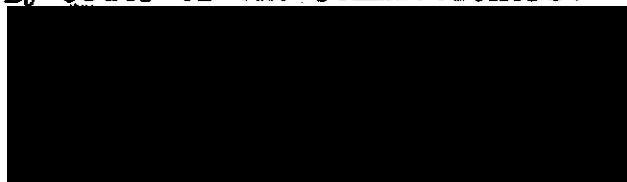

dated 20th and 26th May and 2nd June and registered in the Books of Council and Session on 8th June, all days of the year 1937, the owners of the Monument known as Galdenoch Castle (in ruins) situated 30 yards east by north of the south-eastmost corner of the main block of farm buildings at Meikle Galdenoch, 60 yards north-west of the Green Burn at its nearest point and 180 yards south-west by west of the junction of said Burn with the Galdenoch Burn, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm of Galdenoch Meikle situated in the Parish of Leswalt and County of Wigtown.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

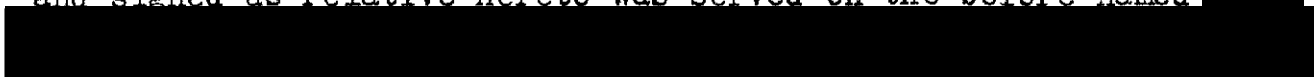

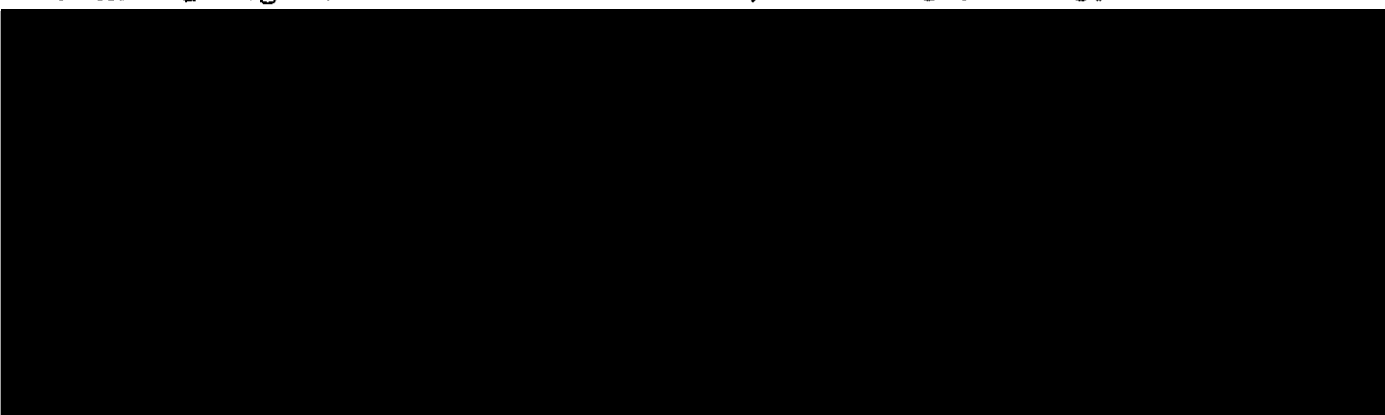

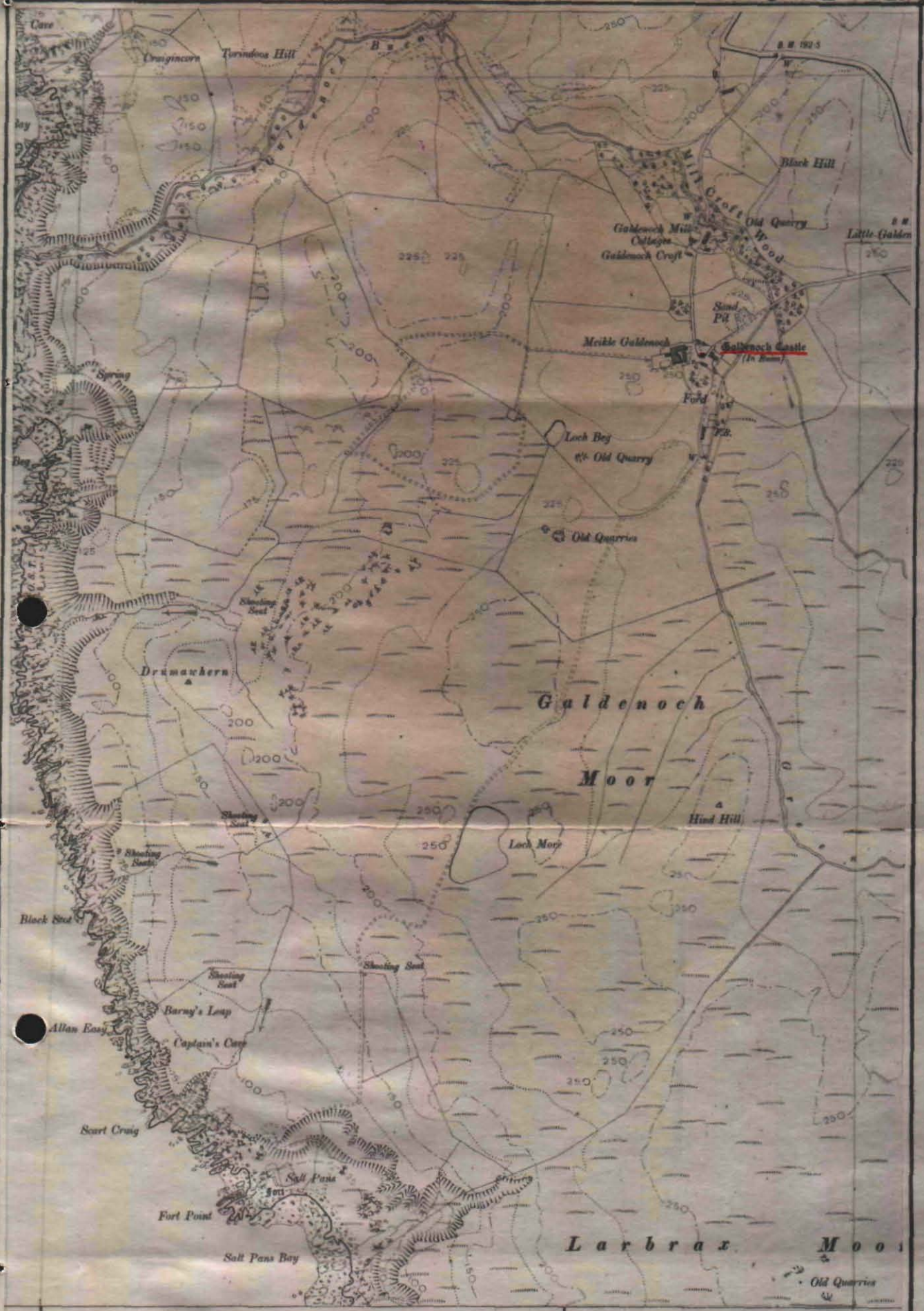
