
IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

 the owner of the Monument known as the Old Tower or Place of Sorbie (in ruins) situated within the former Old Tower Plantation and consisting of (First) the larger wing contained within a rectangular area of ground measuring forty feet three inches on each of its north-east and south-west sides and twenty-four feet on each of its south-east and north-west sides and (Second) the smaller wing projecting from the north-east side of said larger wing at its south-east end and contained within a rectangular area of ground measuring twenty feet on each of its north-east and south-west sides and fifteen feet nine inches on each of its south-east and north-west sides, the southmost corner of said first-mentioned area being situated seventy-five yards north-west by north of the northmost corner of Sorbie Tower Cottage, one hundred yards north at its nearest point of the Wigtown and Whithorn Branch of the Portpatrick and Wigtownshire Joint Railway now the London Midland and Scottish Railway and one thousand and twenty yards south-west by south of the south corner of the southmost farm building at Sorbie Farm, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Sorbie Farm situated in the Parish of Sorbie and County of Wigtown.



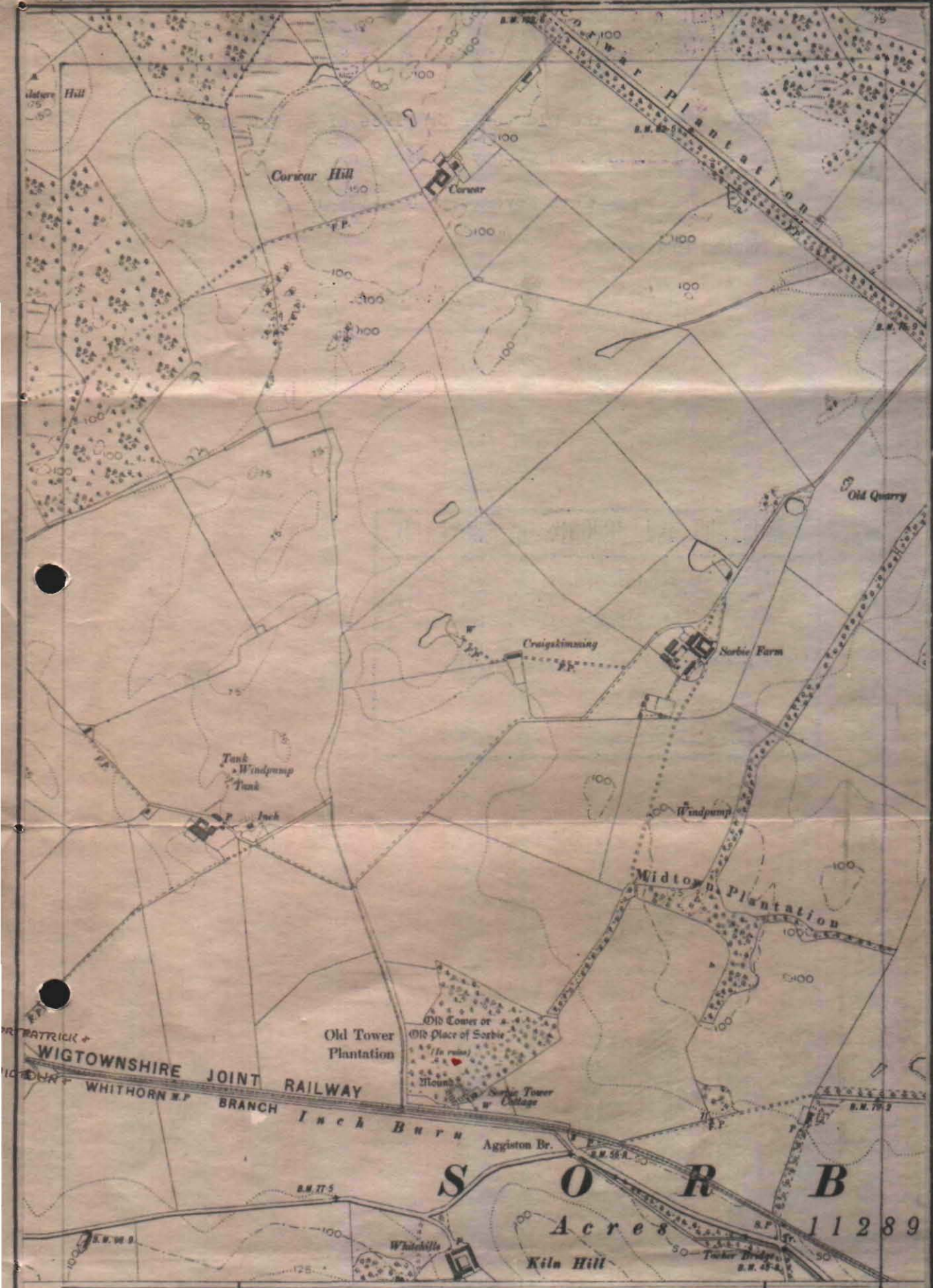
