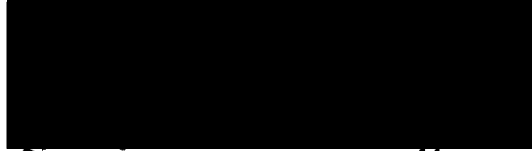
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Lands and Estate of Lochend and others

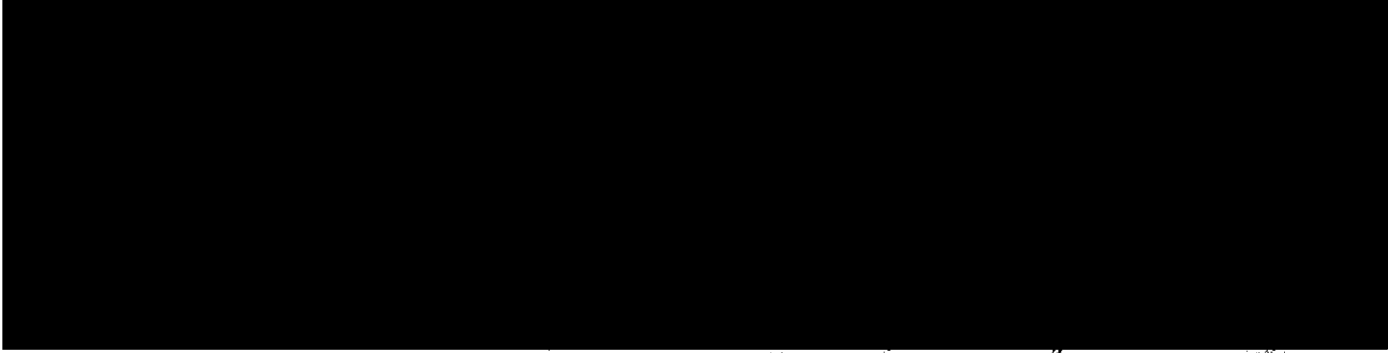

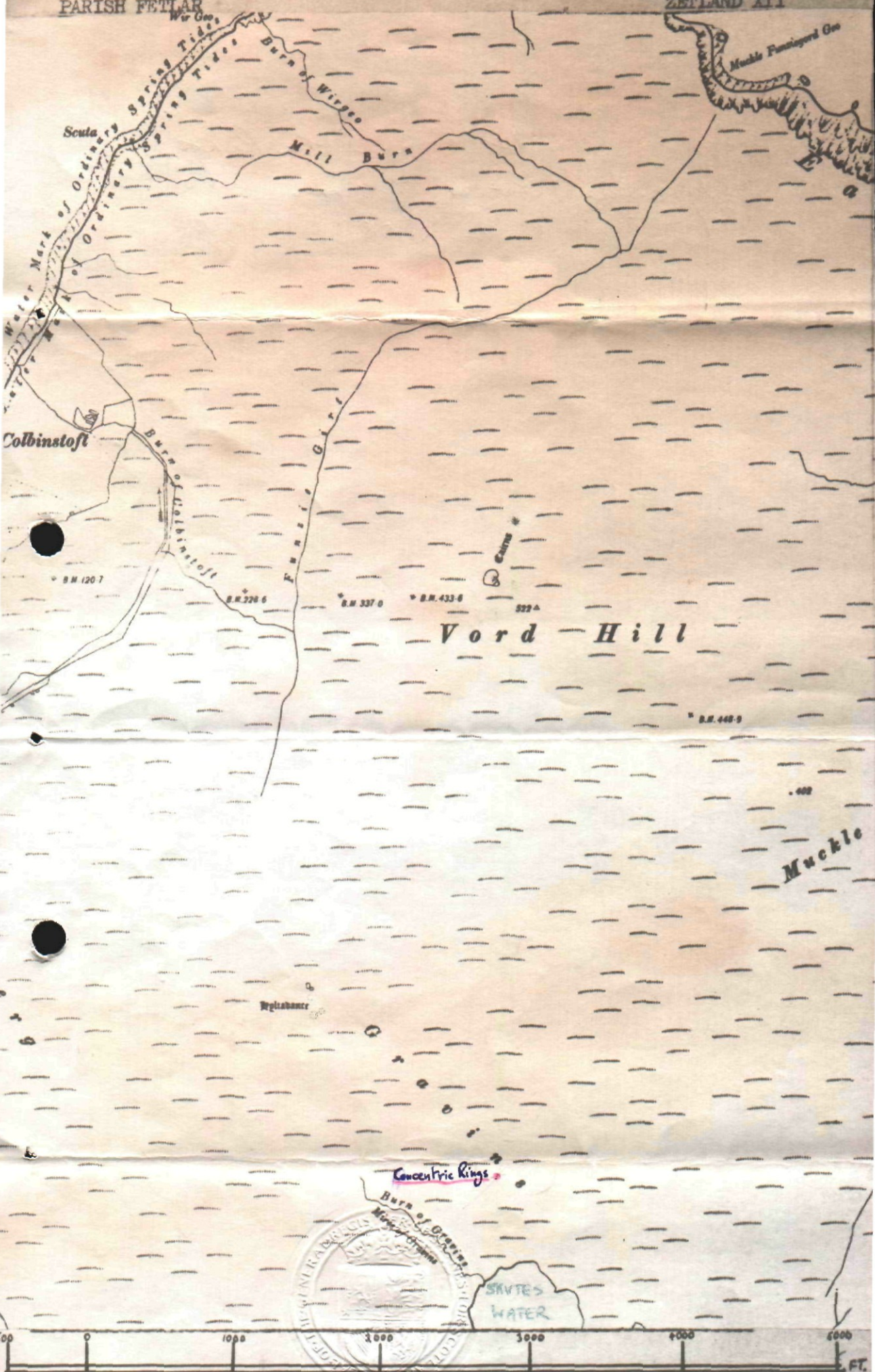
