the owners of the Monuments known as the three Cairns or Tumuli situated on the Holm of Melby on the West coast of the Mainland consisting of (First) the North westmost tumulus occupying a circular area of ground 40 feet in diameter the northmost point of said area being situated 200 feet East North East of the high-water mark on the West coast of said Holm of Melby at its nearest point, 300 feet South of the high-water mark on the North coast of said Holm at its nearest point and 580 feet West of the high-water mark on the East coast of said Holm at its nearest point: (Second) the tumulus to the East of the first mentioned tumulus occupying a circular area of ground 60 feet in diameter the northmost point of said area being situated 315 feet South of the high-water mark on the North coast of said Holm at its nearest point, 160 feet West South West of the high-water mark on the East coast of said Holm at its nearest point and 600 feet North by East of the high-water mark on the South coast of said Holm at its nearest point; and (Third) the tumulus to the West South West of last mentioned tumulus occupying a circular area of ground 70 feet in diameter the northmost point of said area being situated 300 feet East of the high-water mark on the West coast of said Holm at its nearest point, 445 feet South by East of the high-water mark on the North coast of said Holm and 500 feet West by North of the high-water mark on the East coast of said Holm at its nearest point being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Holm and Papa Sound called Melby Holm situated in the Parish of Walls and Sandness and County of Zetland.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

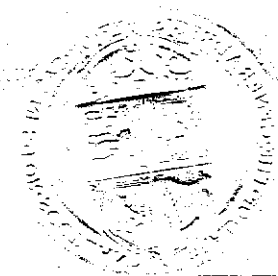

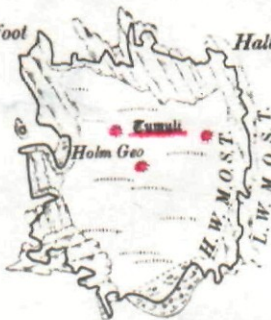
