

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 2055
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Broch of Culswick comprises a broch of Iron Age date, built probably between 500 BC and AD 200. The broch is visible as a circular upstanding building, about 16m in diameter, encircled by a low rampart. The broch wall has a pronounced batter and stands up to 3m high. The monument lies about 45m above sea level, on the summit of a conical hill. The area to be scheduled is circular on plan, 60m in diameter centred on the centre of the broch, to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Sandsting and the County of Orkney and Zetland as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

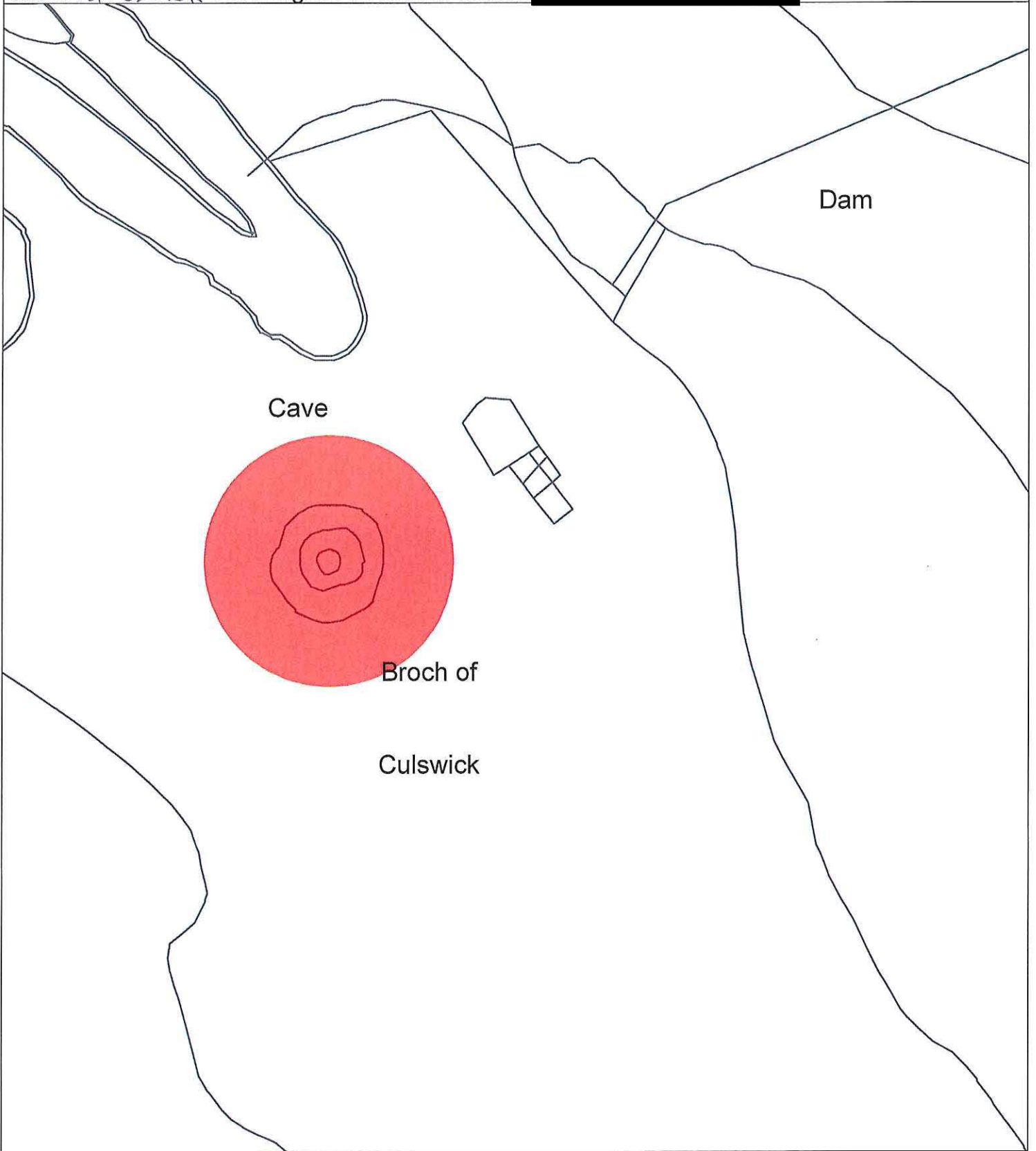
