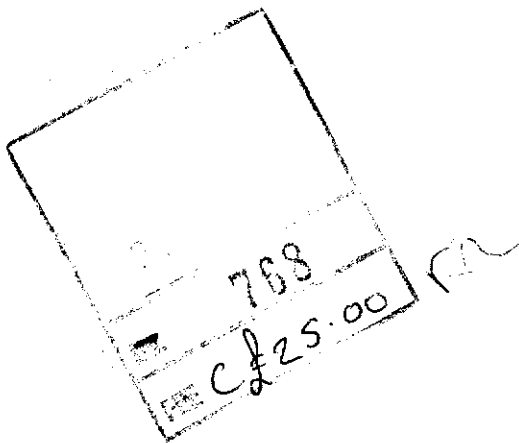

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Hawks Ness, broch at Corbie Geo, dated 5 February 1954 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the Counties of Orkney and Zetland on 8 October 1954 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as a circle of 45m across as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

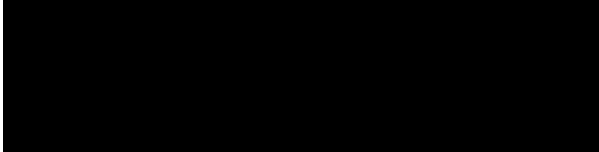

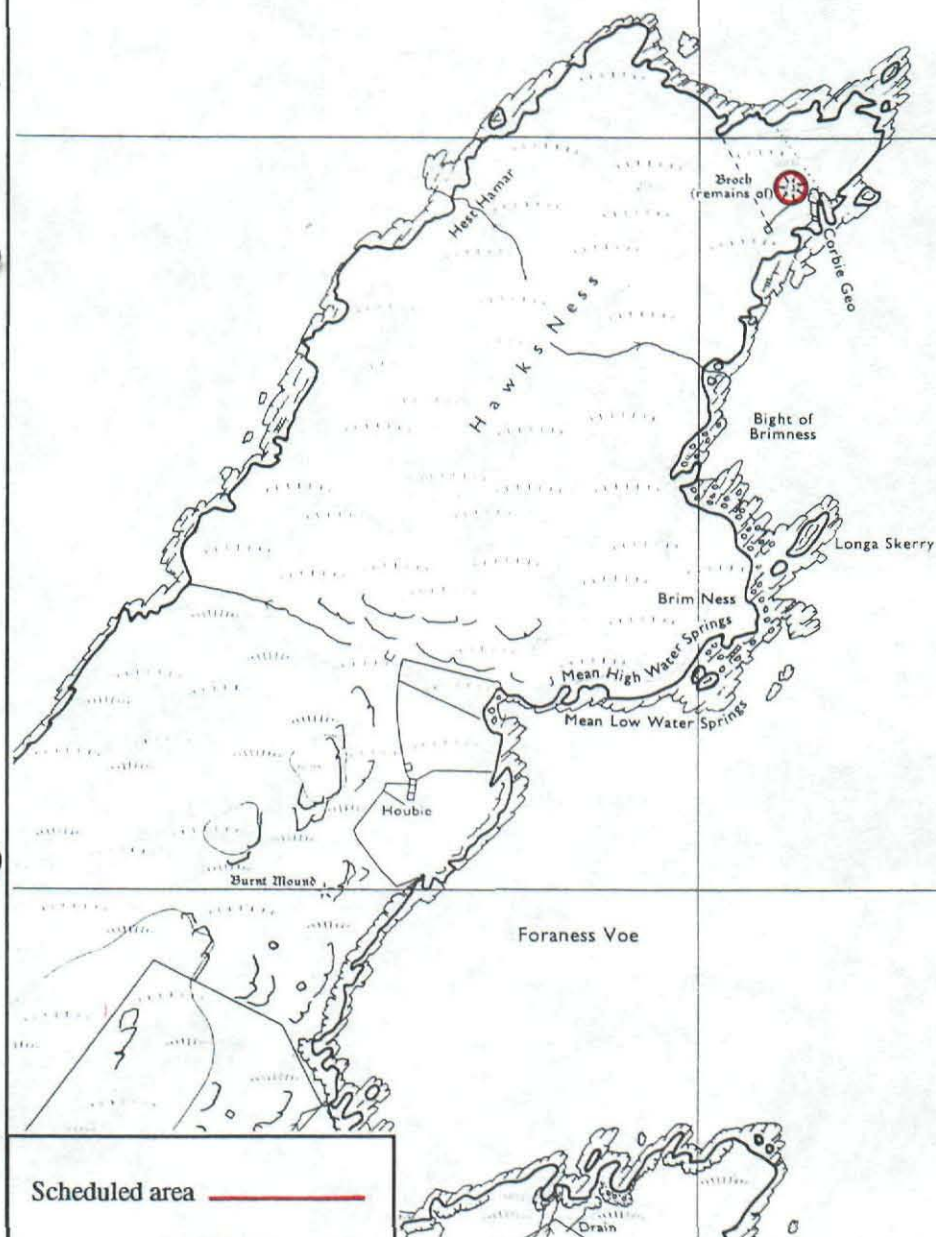

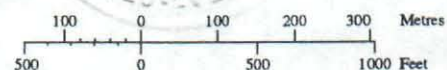
Hawks Ness, broch at Corbie Geo
