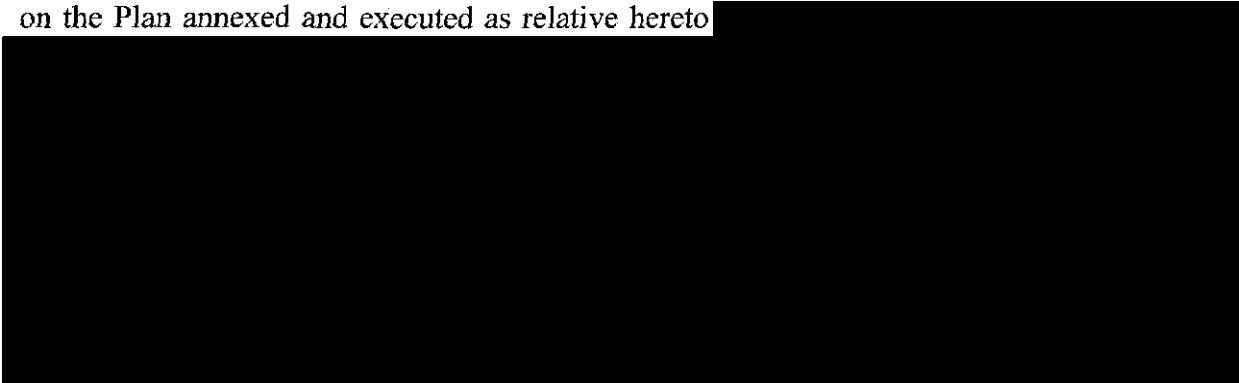

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Scousburgh, broch behind Rhu-allen comprises the remains of a broch, an Iron Age fortified settlement. The area to be scheduled includes the mound and an area around it on the S, SW, W and NW sides. On the N, NE and E sides the edge of the scheduled area is defined by existing fences. The area measures a maximum of 55m from its westernmost to its easternmost point by 28m transversely. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dunrossness and the County of Orkney and Zetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

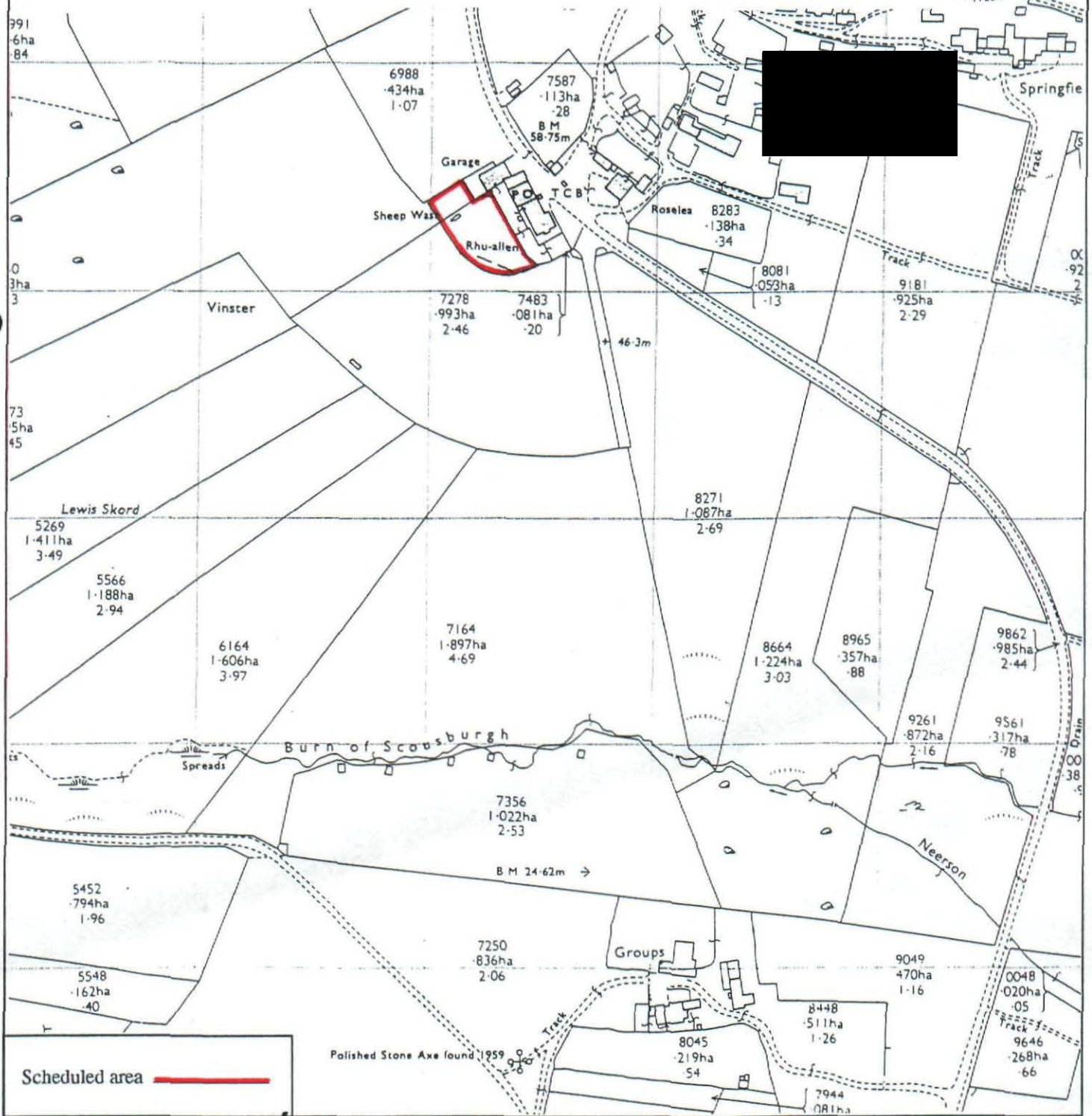

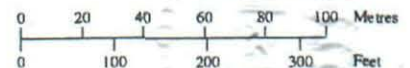
Scousburgh, broch behind Rhu-allen
